Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company hereby makes application for an exception to Rule 2, Order No. R-2800, to permit the establishment of a 40-acre nonstandard proration unit for its Lea 373 "A" Well No. 1 completed in the Monument-Tubb pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Said well is located 1980' from the south line and 660' from the east line in Unit I of Section 34, T-19-S, R-37-E, and was completed as a marginal oil well with an initial potential of 25 barrels of oil per day. The 40-acre nonstandard proration unit consists of the NE/4 of the SE/4 of said Section 34.
