This subject well is an old completion. It was reclassified as a gas well 2-1-65 by order of OCC. Although this well formerly produced as a gas well, a NSP number was never assigned. It is our request that an 80 acre non-standard proration unit be assigned this well; located 1980' from South Line and 1980' from East Line of Section 26. This 80 acres being the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, of Lea County.

The Blinebry Zone is in the Blinebry Gas Pool. El Paso Natural Gas Company has an operating meter run at this location. A satisfactory packer leakage test was taken on this well April 12, 1966. The distillate from this zone will be commingled on your Administrative Order No. MC-1531.

Reference is made to your request dated September 15, 1966, for an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the N/2 SE/4 of Section 26, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to your S. E. Cone Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the South and East lines of said Section 26, and the plat of offset operators.

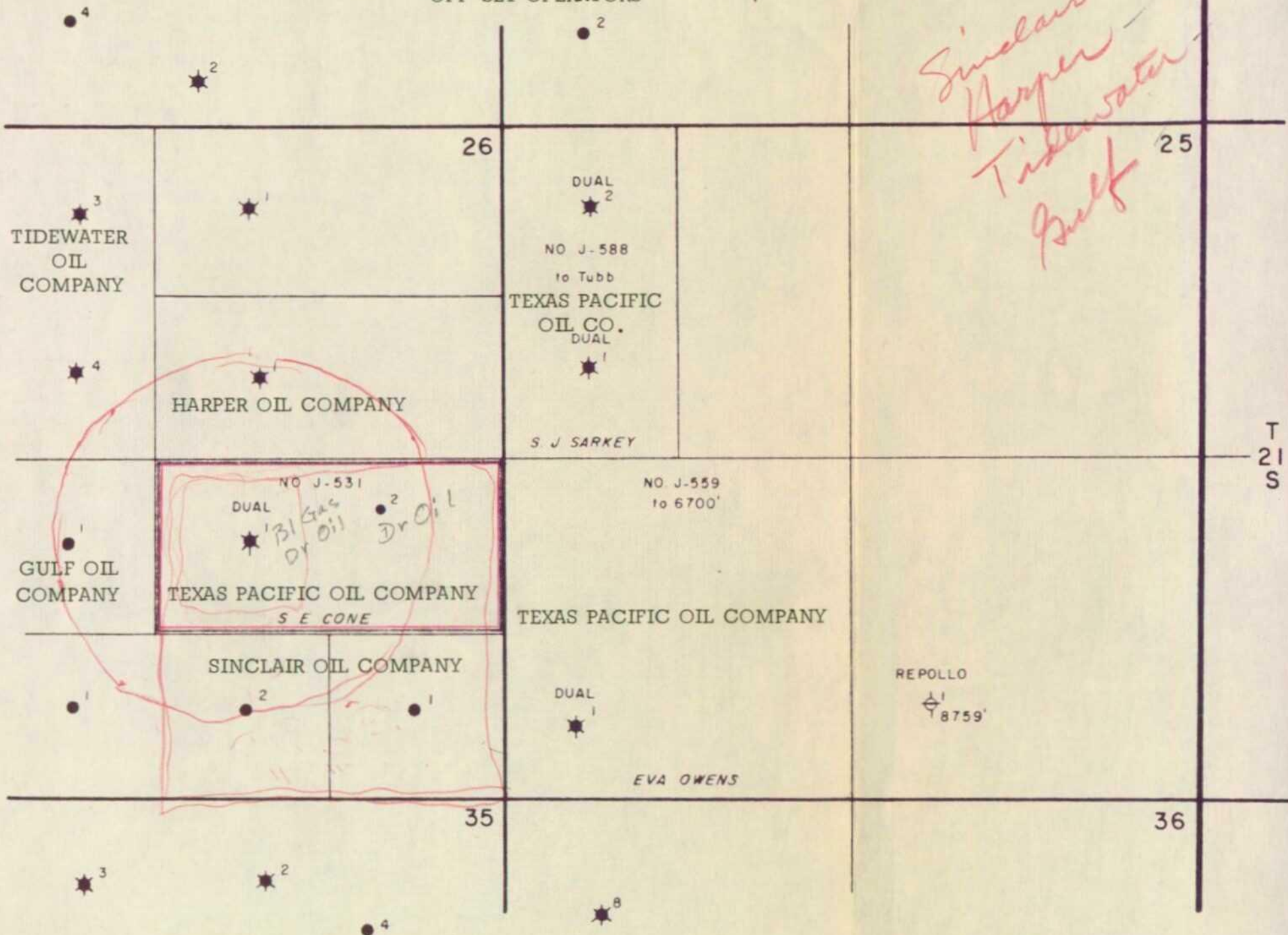


