Gentlemen:

NSP 788 NSP 787  
NSP Orders 778 and 779 dated March 8, 1967, authorized the allowable of our Hawk B-1 Wells Nos. 2 and 4 effective upon date of connection to a gas transportation facility. Well No. 2 was connected to El Paso's system on March 22, 1967, with very little delay because the well had previously been connected to their system and the facilities were still in place. Well No. 4 had not previously been connected to El Paso's gathering system and it was necessary to secure FPC approval. Connection to this well was made on July 19, 1967.

Confirming the conversation in your office yesterday, it is respectfully requested that you reconsider the request made in our letter of transmittal on these applications dated February 2, 1967. This request was that the allowable be assigned effective July 1, 1966, which was the date that the wells were reclassified from Blinebry oil to Blinebry gas.
