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Gentlemen:

We respectfully request your approval for a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of Unit "M" of Section 3, T-21-S, R-37-E. This unit is to be dedicated to Shell's Livingston No. 11, located 3300 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 3. This acreage was previously designated as a non-standard gas proration unit by Administrative Order NSP 630, dated December 31, 1962.

Since the date of this order, however, Livingston No. 11 was re-classified as a Blinebry oil well and now is to be classified as a gas well, effective January 1, 1968.

In view of the facts presented, it is requested that the Commission approve this application for a non-standard gas proration unit.
