Gentlemen:

Atlantic Richfield respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Order R-1670, Rule 29, for a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool. The subject unit will comprise the E/2, SW/4, and the NW/4, SW/4 of Section 29, T-21S, R-37E, as shown on the attached plat. Two wells in the unit area produce from the Blinebry Gas Pool. The H. S. Turner No. 3 is a marginal Blinebry gas well located 660' FSL and 1980' FWL of Section 29, currently assigned an 80-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the E/2, SW/4 of Section 29, and known as the Turner Gas Com. The W. H. Turner No. 1, located 2310' FSL and 990' FWL of Section 29, is a former Blinebry oil well, reclassified to gas on December 1, 1970, because of an excessively high gas-oil ratio. The well is awaiting connection to the El Paso gathering system and assignment of a provisional 40-acre allowable based upon the NW/4, SW/4 of Section 29. We request the assignment of allowables equivalent to the volume of gas allocated to a single 120-acre proration unit, as set forth in Rule 29, and propose, as operator, to determine the proportion of allowable to be produced by each well in the unit.

Attached are amended copies of Form C-102 for the W. H. Turner No. 1 and H. S. Turner No. 3 wells. Copies of this application have been submitted to the offset operators listed below.

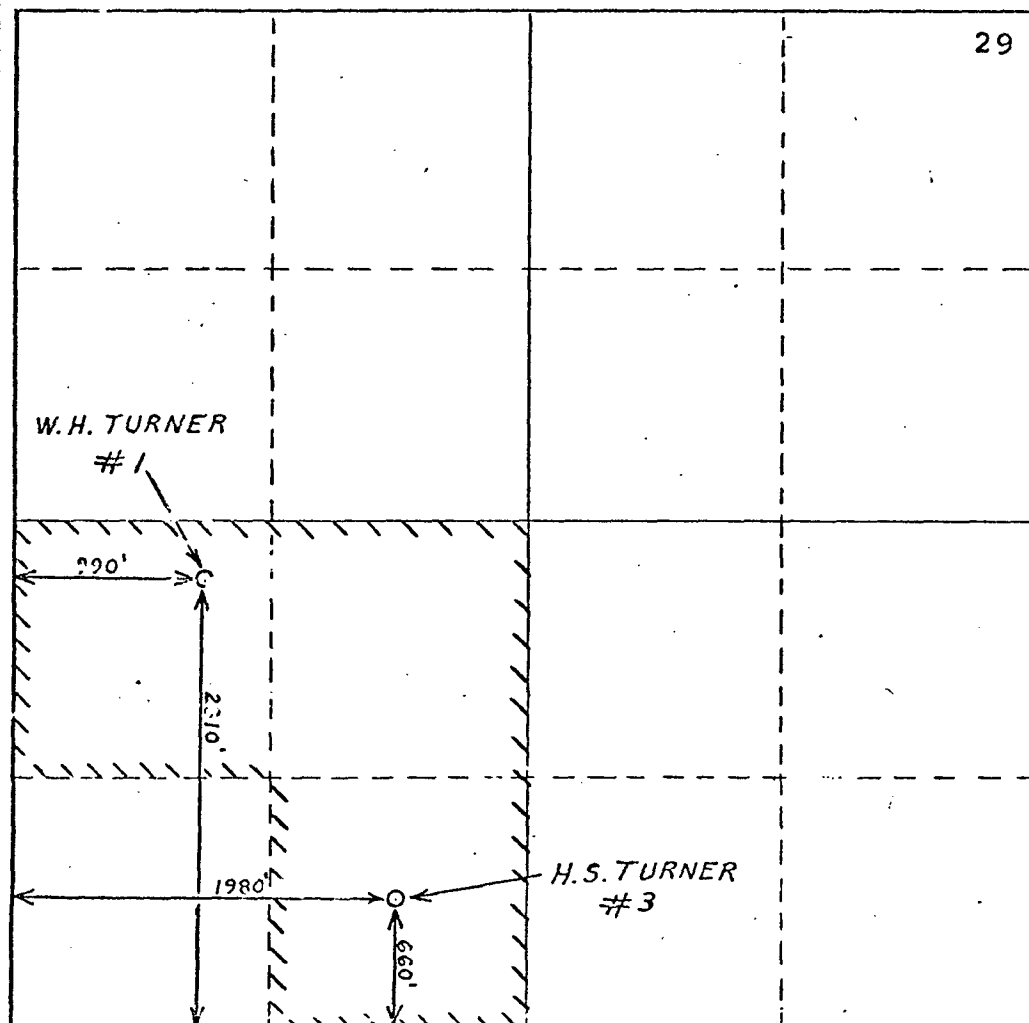

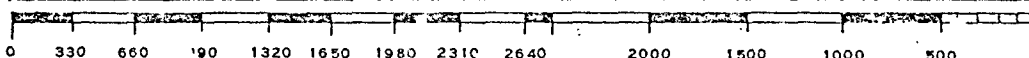
