NSP grantet Mobil Oil Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval to a nonstandard gas unit for the Carson-Watson Com Well #13. The subject well is located in Unit G, Section 33, T21S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The subject & Record on the Carson-Watson Com has been unitized and it contains 79 acres comprised of the S/2 of the NE/4, Section 33, T21S, R37E; less and except one (1) 8 R(670) square acre designated as school land located in the southeast corner of the aforementioned S/2 of NE/4. The requested non-standard unit consists of contiguous tracts that lie wholly within a single governmental quarter section.

The proposed Tubb Gas completion in the Carson-Watson Com #13 will be a replacement well to the existing Tubb Gas completion in the Carson-Watson Com Well #2, which will be shut-in in the Tubb Pool concurrent with the successful completion of the well in this request. The existing wellbore of the proposed Carson-Watson Com #13 is presently completed in the Brunson Ellenburger Pool as the E. O. Carson #13; however, this completion will be squeezed upon approval of this request.

The proposed Carson-Watson Com #13 is intended to ultimately be a dual completion in the herein requested Tubb Gas Pool and later as a Drinkard injection well in the Gulf operated Central Drinkard Unit. Application for the dual Drinkard completion will be filed by either Mobil or Gulf at a later date.

The offset operators are hereby being notified of this application by this letter through registered mail. By this letter we are further requesting the consent of the offset operators to the subject non-standard unit by their written waivers.


