Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM  
Section 23: SE/4 NW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Zattu Cushing Well No. 1, located 2310 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 23.

Waivers of objection have been received from offsetting operators and the waiting period prescribed by Rule 104 D II may be dispensed with in this instance.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 D II, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit.

In accordance with the provisions of Order No. R-1670, application is hereby made on behalf of Sam D. Ares for a non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

The non-standard unit to consist of one quarter-quarter section being the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, containing 40 acres, more or less. Production to be from the Zattu Cushing No. 1, located 2310 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 23. The entire 40 acres may reasonably be presumed to be gas productive.

Enclosed are letters of consent from Gulf Oil Company, Phillips Petroleum Company, Texas Pacific Oil Company and Worldwide Energy Corporation, being all the offset operators as shown on the attached plat.

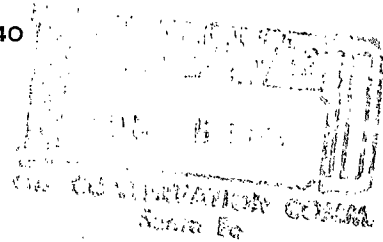
