Amended Administrative Order NSP-931

Dear Mr. Adams:

Reference is made to your application dated October 26, 1989 to include the Burton Flat-Atoka Gas Pool into the provisions of Administrative Order NSP-931, which order authorized a 298.91acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Burton Flat-Morrow Gas Pool comprising the following acreage:

> EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO Section 4: Lots 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15 and 16

It is our understanding that the Morrow zone in the well dedicated to said acreage, being the Federal "4" Com Well No. 1, located 2787 feet from the North line and 860 feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 4, has been abandoned and the well has been recompleted in the Atoka formation.

By authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.D.II., the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Burton Flat-Atoka Gas Pool is hereby approved.

Division Administrative Order NSP-931, dated September 21, 1973 and corrected September 27, 1973 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
