Amended Administrative Order NSP-1039

Dear Mr. Dickerson:

Reference is made to your letter on behalf of M. Brad Bennett, Inc. dated November 23, 1988 and as directed by Division Order No. R-8792, issued in Case No. 9519 and dated December 14, 1988. Division Administrative Order NSP-1039, dated January 26, 1977 authorized a 304-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of Lots 17 and 18, the E/2 SW/4, and the SE/4 of Section 6, Township 16 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to the Mark Production Company State "E" Com Well No. 1 located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit V) of said Section 6.


At this time, said Administrative Order NSP-1039 is hereby amended to reflect to following additions and changes:

- 1) the aforementioned non-standard gas proration unit in the Pennsylvanian formation (which includes, but not necessarily limited to the Hume-Atoka Gas Pool and the Hume-Morrow Gas Pool) shall now be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a previously approved unorthodox gas well location (see R-8792) 660 feet from the South and East lines (Unit X) of said Section 6;
- 2) the aforementioned State "E" Com Well No. 1 is to be recompleted into the Wolfcamp formation; therefore, all provisions in said Order NSP-1039 shall be limited only to the Wolfcamp formation until further notice; and,
- 3) M. Brad Bennett, Inc. shall be named the operator of the aforementioned units and wells.

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By authority granted me under the provision of Rule 104.D.II and Order No. R-8792, the above-described amendments shall become effective immediately.
