Administrative Order NSP-1040

Dear Mr. Westbrook:

Reference is made to your application dated March 2, 1992 requesting the reinstatement of Division Administrative Order NSP-1040, dated February 25, 1977, which authorized the 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool underlining the E/2 SE/4 of Section 35, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and had dedicated thereon the Cities Service Federal Well No. 4 located 990 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line (Unit P) of said Section 35, and the simultaneous dedication of said 80-acre unit to the Cities Service Federal Well No. 2 located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit P) of said Section 35.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said pool rules based upon the unit size of 80-acres.

Further, Division Administrative Order NSP-1122, dated January 3, 1979, which authorized a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit for said Well No. 4 comprising the SE/4 of said Section 35, is hereby placed in abeyance until further notice.
