Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for three non-standard proration units consisting of the following acreage in the Vada-Pennsylvanian Pool in Lea County, New Mexico:

An 80-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the S/2 SW/4 of Section 11, Township 9 South, Range 34 East, to be dedicated to the old Superior Pyron Well No. 1 located 510 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of said section.

An 80-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the S/2 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 34 East, to be dedicated to the old BTA Odell Well No. 1 located 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said section.

An 80-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the N/2 SE/4 of Section 10, Township 9 South, Range 34 East, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a point 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said section.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3 of Order No. R-3179-A, the above non-standard proration units are hereby approved.
