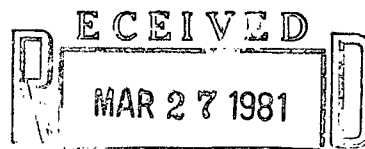

Gentlemen:

Recently I filed a C-101 and C-102 with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division district office in Hobbs for permission to drill a second Jalmat (Gas) well as an infill well at a standard location consisting of 1880 FSL and 660 FWL Section 6, and situated on an existing 160-acre proration unit comprised of the SW/4 Section 6, T-23-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Since the subject well is located on a previously dedicated 160-acre standard proration unit, I hereby file for administrative approval to dedicate the proposed well as a second well on the subject proration unit. #3

Three copies of a plat showing the location of the original well on the existing 160-acre proration unit plus the location of the proposed well are enclosed.

Copies of this plat and application have also been sent to all offsetting parties owning Jalmat dry gas rights. The following is a list of the offset Jalmat owners.

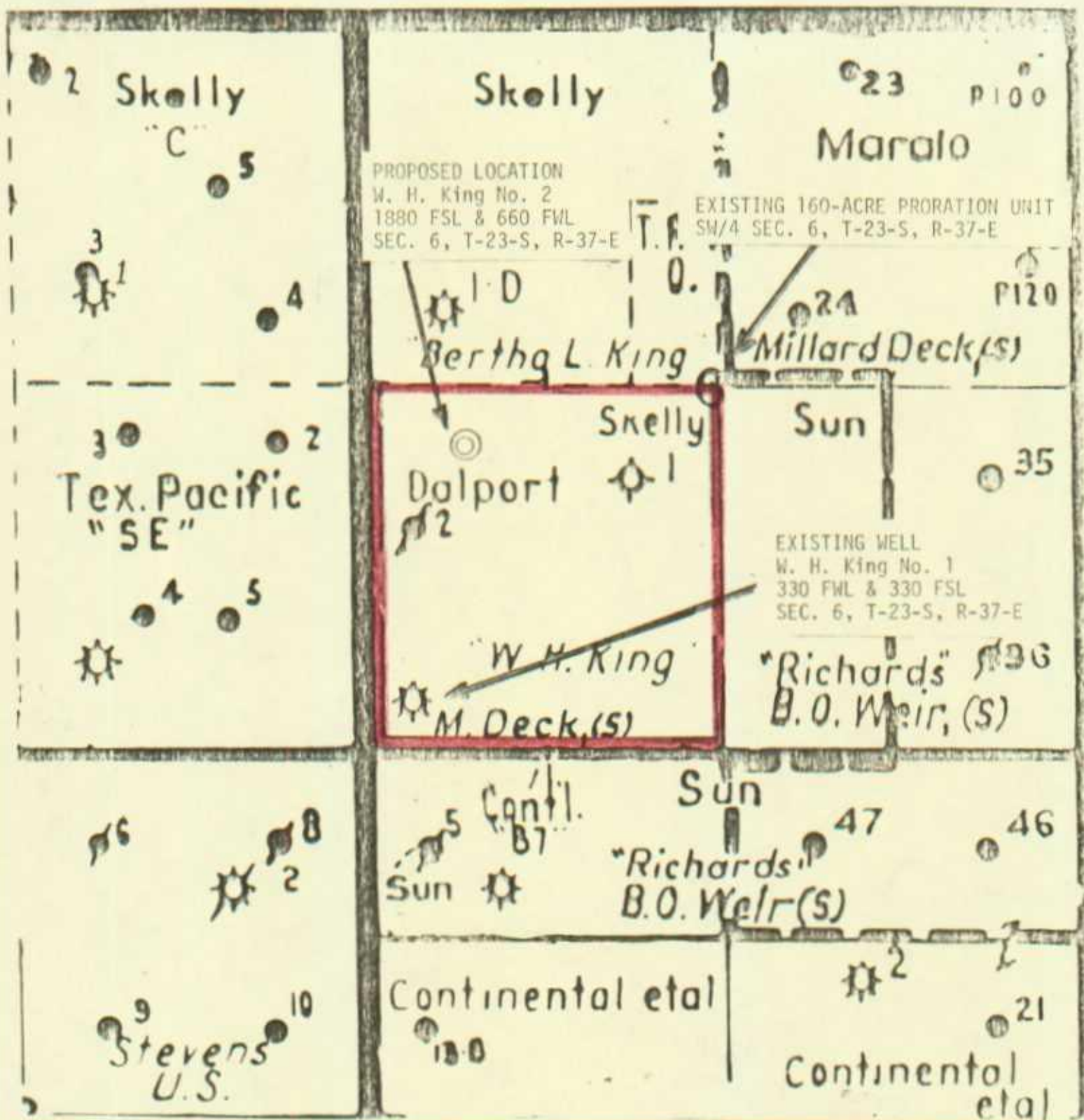

NOTE: Proposed well is the second well on an existing 160-acre Jalmat (Gas) Proration Unit

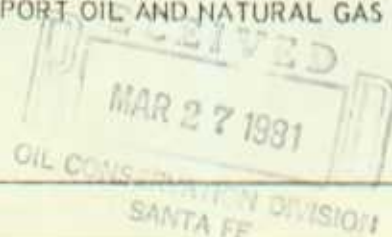
JALMAT GAS POOL T-23-S, R-37-E

Gentlemen:

We are in receipt of a copy of the captioned request, along with copies of forms C-101, and C-102 for Doyle Hartman #3 King, to be located in Unit L, Section 6, T-23-S, R-37-E. Form C-101 states that the proposed well will be drilled to a total depth of 3700 feet and will be completed as a Jalmat (Yates) gas producer. The information available to us indicates that the base of the Jalmat pool at this location is at approximately 3450 feet, so that a well drilled to 3700 feet would penetrate the Langlie Mattix field by 250 feet.



We are also in receipt of form C-104 for Doyle Hartman #1 King, located in unit M, Section 6, T-23-S, R-37-E. The reason for filing is given as Change in Ownership. Cities Service Company owns a 1/6 Mineral Interest under SW/4 Section 6, and has participated with Dalport Oil Corporation since 1949 as a working interest owner in this quarter-section. Cities Service is not aware of any change in ownership under this quarter-section.
