Re: Request for Non-Standard Pennsylvanian Gas Proration Unit.

Dear Mr. Ramey:

GREAT WESTERN DRILLING COMPANY, holder of the operating rights in Federal oil and gas lease NM-15862, has filed an Application For Permit to Drill Well No. 1 Quail Federal, a 5200' Penn test located 660 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line of Section 3, T-6-S, R-25-E, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.

Section 3-6S-25E is a fractional section and the entire section contains a total of only 177.50 acres.

Due to the unorthodox size of this section, the proration unit for a Pennsylvanian gas well cannot be the normal 320 acre half section. Inasmuch as the wellsite is located not closer than 1980 feet from the nearest end boundary, not closer than 660 feet from the nearest side boundary, nor closer than 330 feet from any inner (lot) boundary, the wellsite is at an orthodox location for a Pennsylvanian gas well.

GREAT WESTERN DRILLING COMPANY hereby makes application for administrative approval for a non-standard proration unit for the Pennsylvanian formation underlying the following described acreage:

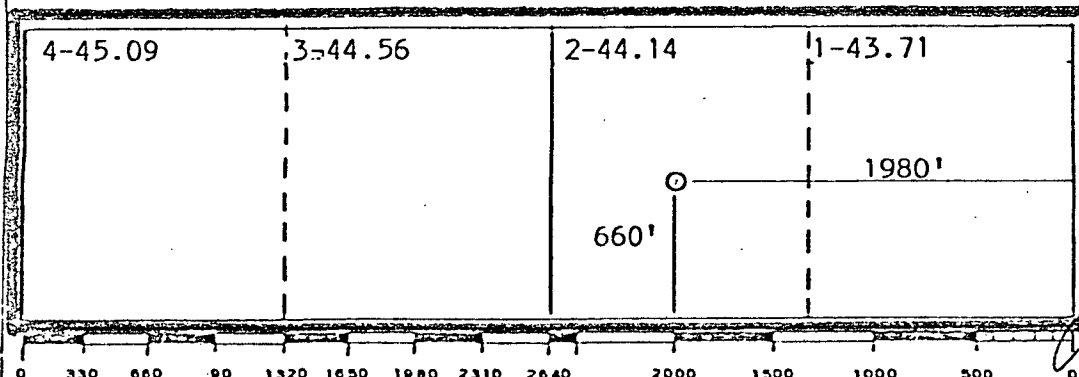

GREAT WESTERN DRILLING COMPANY, holder of the operating rights in Federal oil and gas lease NM-15862, has filed an Application For Permit to Drill Well No. 1 Quail Federal, a 5200' Penn test located 660 feet from the south line and 1980 feet from the east line of Section 3, T-6-S, R-25-E, N.M.P.M., Chaves County, New Mexico.

Section 3-6S-25E is a fractional section and the entire section contains a total of only 177.50 acres.

Due to the unorthodox size of this section, proration unit or units for an Abo gas well cannot be the normal 160 acre unit substantially in form of a square. Inasmuch as the wellsite is located not closer than 660 feet to any outer boundary of the section nor closer than 330 feet to any inner (lot) boundary, the wellsite is at an orthodox location for an Abo gas well.

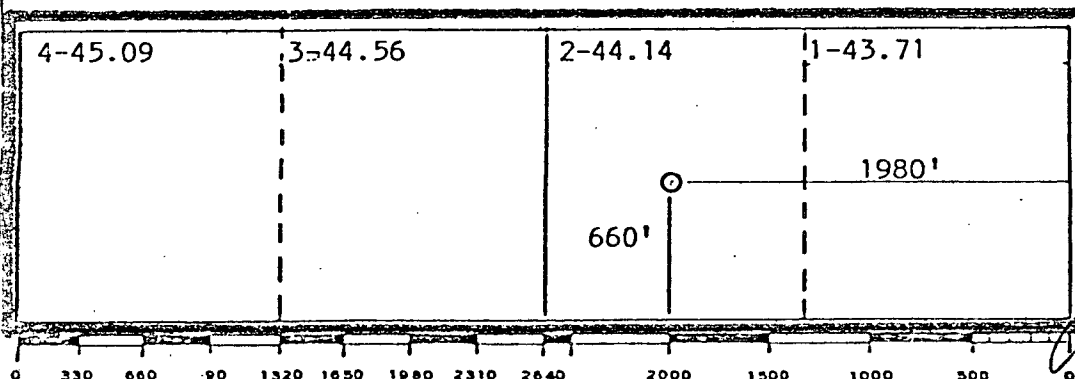
