Dear Mr. Newell:

Reference is made to your application dated June 23, 1995 for a 145-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 19: Lots 2, 3, and 4 and the NE/4 SW/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to the following four existing wells all within ARCO's State "F" DE Lease:

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 and 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit and resulting

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
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unorthodox gas well locations are hereby approved. Also, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU from all four wells in any proportion.

The current 145-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit comprising Lots 2, 3, and 4 and the SE/4 SW/4 of said Section 19, which had been simultaneously dedicated to the State "E" DE Well Nos. 1, 2, 4, and 5, under authority of Division Administrative Order NSP-1326, dated September 1, 1982 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
