This letter constitutes an application for Administrative Approval of Non-Standard Proration Unit pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Rule No. 104 D II. In support of our application, we enclose the following:

1. Waiver letters from Alpha Twenty One Production Company, Arco Oil & Gas Company and Culbertson & Irwin, constituting all the offset operators to this location.
2. Land map showing the proposed proration unit. The proposed unit is outlined in yellow.

Nancy Federal No. 1 was originally completed as a Langlie-Mattix Gas Well but has become uneconomic due to excessive water production. Mr. Burleson proposes to plug the well and recomplete it as a Jalmat gas producer. He intends to dedicate the E/2 SW/4 of Section 28, T25S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico to the well located 2310' FWL and 990' FSL of said Section.

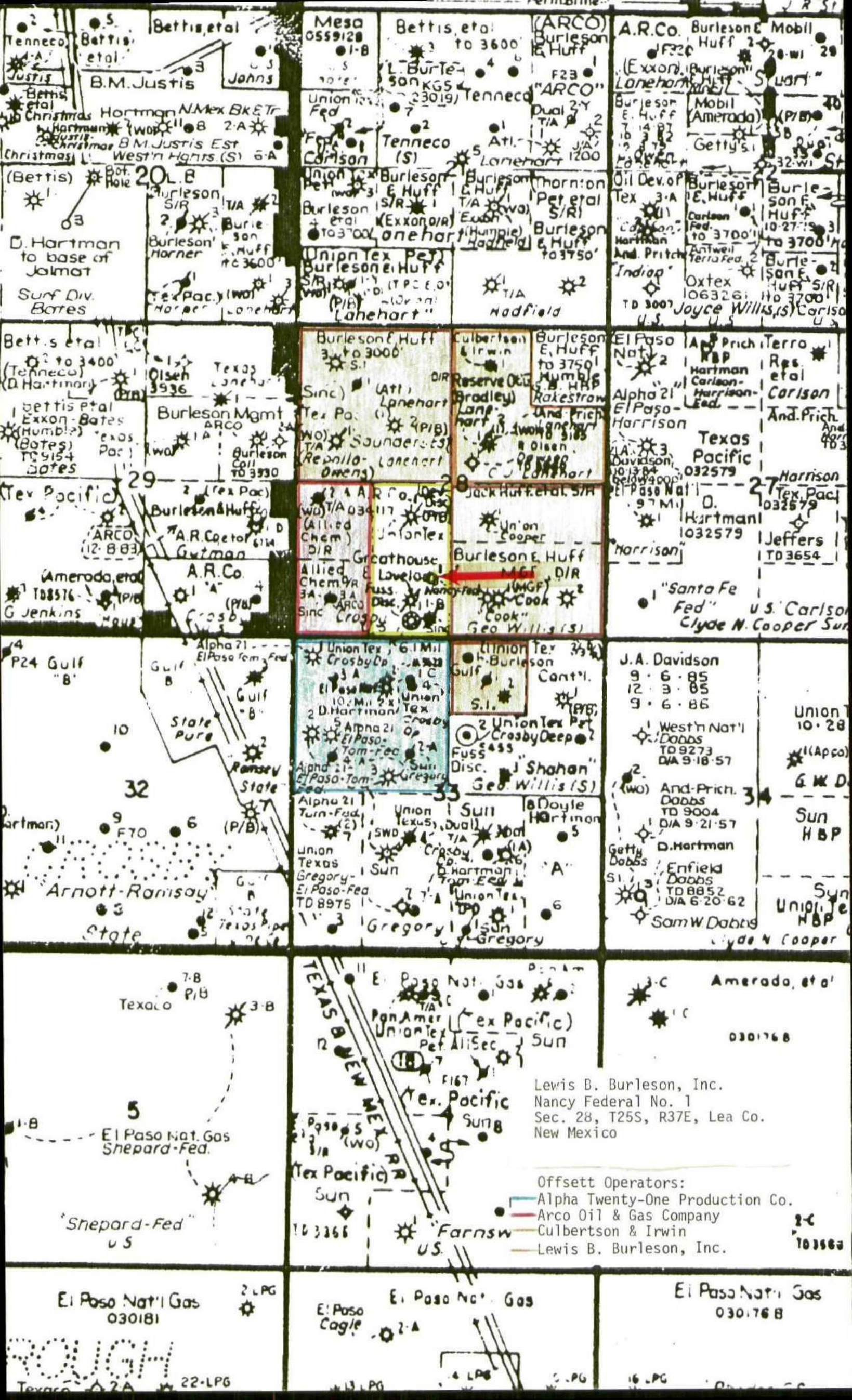
