

Dear Sir:

Marathon Oil Company requests administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit of 40 acres for the above referenced well. The exact location of the L. G. Warlick "C" Well No. 10 is:

1725' FSL and 2149' FEL
Unit J, Section 15, T21S, R37E
Lea County, New Mexico

This is presently classified as a Blinebry oil well. Based on the latest GOR test, it is being re-classified to a Blinebry gas well. Production from this well is averaging 2 BOPD, 0 BWPD and 276 MCFPD (GOR = 138,000:1). It is requested that the NW/4 of the SE/4, Section 15, T21S, R37E be dedicated to this well. Separate metering will be set-up for this well as required.

Offset operators have been notified according to Rule 104. D. II. (d). Copies of the letter sent to them and proof of mailing is enclosed. A C-102 outlining the dedicated acreage is also attached. If any further information is necessary please contact this office. Thank you.




