APPLICATION FOR A 40-ACRE NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION UNIT

Gentlemen:

Chevron U.S.A. Inc. respectfully requests administrative approval for a 40-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, comprising the SW/4 of NW/4 of Section 28, T-21-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico, to be assigned to Chevron's Funice King Well No. 24. In support thereof, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. states the following facts:

- That NMOCD Order No. R-5264, effective September 1, 1976, authorized the simultaneous dedication of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 NW/4 and W/2 NE/4 of Section 28, T-21-S, R-37-E, Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to Chevron's Eunice King Wells No.s 15 and 24, located in Units F and E of Section 28, 73 respectively.
- 2) That Chevron's Eunice King Well No. 10, located in Unit B of Section 28, T-21-S, R-37-E, has been recompleted as a Blinebry oil well and has been assigned an allowable dedicated to 40-acres comprising the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 28. This reduces the NSP unit for Wells No.s 15 and 24 to 120 acres.
- 3) That Chevron's Eunice King Well No. 15, located in Unit F of Section 28, T-21-S, R-37-E, was reclassified to an oil well effective June 1, 1987, with an allowable dedicated to 40-acres comprising the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 28. This further reduces the NSP unit acreage to where there is only 40-acres of contiguous acreage remaining for Well No. 24.
- 4) The proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit will meet the requirements for a Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit as follows:

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- a. The proposed unit consists of 40-acres that are contiguous.
- b. The proposed unit lies wholly within a single government section in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool.
- c. The entire proposed unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool.
- d. A copy of this application will be sent by certified mail to all offset operators and operators owning interests in the proposed unit's boundary and shall serve as notification.

In support of this application, attached is a plat outlining the proposed Non-Standard Unit, the acreage to be dedicated to the proposed unit, and showing all offset operated properties and wells.

In view of the facts submitted, Chevron U.S.A. Inc. requests that administrative approval of the subject 40-acre Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit be granted.



Gentlemen:

An oil allowable has been assigned to Eunice King #10, and the #15 was reclassified to oil effective June 1st. This leaves only 40 acres of the 160 acre NSP which can be dedicated to your gas well completion #24-E since the other 40 acres in this 160-acre NSP is not contiguous with Unit E.

Your gas allowable acreage was reduced to 40 effective July 1, but it will still be necessary for you to make an application for and receive approval of a 40-acre NSP for well #24. It is our policy to allow 60 days for you to obtain approval of your NSP.

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Gentlemen:

Your Eunice King #10-B has been recompleted as a Blinebry oil well. This well is located on 40 acres of the 160 acre proration unit dedicated to #15 and #24. Therefore this acreage must be deleted from the 160-acre proration unit.

Today we received Form C-116 with a request that the Eunice King #15-F be reclassified from gas to oil. This will further reduce the 160-acre proration unit.

An oil allowable is being assigned to well #10 and well #15 will be reclassified from gas to oil effective June 1, 1987, You are hereby requested to submit your application for a 40-acre NSP for well #24 as soon as possible.

It will be necessary to submit revised acreage dedication plats for well #15 and #24.

Also, if the gas transporter on well #15 changed due to the reclassification, please submit a change of gas transporter on Form C-104.

APPLICATION OF GULF OIL CORPORATION FOR A NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION UNIT AND SIMULTANEOUS DEDICATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on August 18, 1976, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner, Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>31st</u> day of August, 1976, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, seeks approval for a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 NW/4 and W/2 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks to simultaneously dedicate to said non-standard unit its Eunice King Wells Nos. 5 and 24, located in Units F and E, respectively, of said Section 28, with unit production to be taken from said wells in any proportion.

(4) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the subject wells.

(5) That the applicant further seeks authority to later substitute its Eunice King Well No. 15, located 2086 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 28 for the aforesaid Well No. 5 in the above-described simultaneous dedication.

(6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights. -2-Case No. 5742 Order No. R-5264

(7) That Commission Order No. R-4368 and Administrative Order NSP-1027, which approved the non-standard gas proration units to be consolidated by this order should be superseded.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That effective at 7:00 a.m. on September 1, 1976, the applicant, Gulf Oil Corporation, is hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the S/2 NW/4 and W/2 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to its Eunice King Wells Nos. 5 and 24, located in Units F and E, respectively, of said Section 28, with unit production to be taken from said wells in any proportion.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that upon a proper showing by the applicant, the Secretary-Director of the Commission may substitute applicant's Eunice King Well No. 15 in Unit F of said Section 28 for the aforesaid Well No. 5 in the above-described simultaneous dedication.

(2) That the allowable assigned to the above-described gas proration unit shall be based upon the unit size of 160-acres and that the operator may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from the subject wells in any proportion.

(3) That Commission Order No. R-4368 and Administrative Order NSP-1027 are hereby superseded.

(4) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
