Reference is made to your application for a 120-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 30: E/2 SE/4 and SW/4 SE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your State "A" Well No. 1 to be drilled 735 feet from the South line and 1929 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said Section 30.

By authority granted me under the provisions of 2(a) 4 of Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above non-standard proration unit is hereby approved.

REMARKS: Since the establishment of gas prorationing in the Eumont Gas Pool, January 1, 1954, there has existed a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit covering this acreage and dedicated to the Cities Service Company State "F" Well No. 2, no order given. The State "F" Well No. 2 has been turned over to the Chevron Eunice Monument South Unit Waterflood Project. The State "A" Well No. 1 is essentially a replacement well for the Cities Service Well No. 3.
