ADDENDUM
Administrative Order NSP-1562

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

It has been brought to my attention that the subject well in Division Administrative Order NSP-1562(L), dated February 13, 1989 was to have been drilled at an unorthodox coal gas well location 630 feet from the North line and 315 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 18, Township 31 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. However said Rosa Unit Well No. 221 was subsequently drilled at a standard coal gas well location 990 feet from the North line and 1260 feet from the East line (Unit A) of said Section 18.

At this time, said well location change is hereby noted and all other provisions of said Order NSP-1562 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.


Reference is made to your applications of November 11 and December 6, 1988 for a 231.89-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool:
