Reference is made to your application of September 29, 1989 for a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 20: E/2

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to the existing Jack A-20 Well No. 9, located at an unorthodox gas well location for said unit 660 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line (Unit A), and Jack A-20 Well No. 10, also located at an unorthodox gas well location for said unit 760 feet from the South line and 1880 feet from the East line (Unit O), and to the proposed Jack A-20 Well No. 11 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 2180 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line (Unit J).

By authority granted me under the provisions of the rules and regulations governing the Jalmat Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170 as amended, the above non-standard gas proration unit is hereby approved along with the other provision requested by the applicant to be included in this order.
