
Reference is made to your application of February 28, 1990 for a 234.16-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool:

RIO ARRIBA, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM
Irregular Section 36: Lots 1 through 4 and the W/2 E/2

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your San Juan 29-6 Unit Well No. 231 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 826 feet from the North line and 947 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 36.
