
Reference is made to your application dated September 19, 1990 for a 225.44-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool:

RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM  
Section 36: Lots 1 through 4, and the W/2 E/2 (E/2 equivalent)

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your San Juan 31-6 Unit Well No. 214 to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location 1560 feet from the North line and 831 feet from the East line (Unit G) of said Section 36.
