Dear Mr. Stogner:

Yates Petroleum Corporation bought this well from Texaco and received only the 40 acres, Unit G, of Lease LC-068124 that the well sets on. Yates wants to recompleate the well in the Todd Lower San Andres pool which requires that 80 acres be dedicated. Since Yates only has 40 acres, we request that Yates be granted, by administrative approval, a non-standard proration unit dedicating the 40 acres to the well.

Enclosed is a copy of the plat (Form C-102) and a copy of the lease map. Offset operators are Texaco USA, Jack McClellan, and Plains Petroleum Operating Company. I have also enclosed a copy of the certification slips that we have notified them of our non-standard location by certified mail, via copy of this letter.




