Dear Mr. Correa:

Reference is made to your application dated August 12, 1994 for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 29: S/2 NW/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to your New Mexico "B" State Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-04817), located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico and to your New Mexico "B" State Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-04818), located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of said Section 29.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit, with allowable assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said special pool rules based upon the unit size of 80 acres.


