Dear Mr. Carson:

In reviewing the subject application, NMOCD records indicate a producing Bluitt-San Andres oil well located to the northwest in Unit "J", being UNOCAL's Federal "17-A" Well No. 1 in which it is reported that the SW/4 NE/4 and the NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 17 is dedicated to form a non-standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit (please note there was no reference to an order approving this non-standard unit found).

Rule 5(b) of the "General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools in Northwest and Southeast New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-5353, as amended, prohibits the simultaneous dedication of any acreage to an oil well and a gas well, as it appears your application is requesting.

Should any of my information be incorrect or out-dated, please clarify. If not, you may wish to amend this application and request to dedicate other acreage other than the entire SE/4 of said Section 17.

Further, please provide me a copy of the Division Order that approved the aforementioned 80-acre non-standard oil proration unit for the No. 1 well.
