Dear Mr. Carson:

In reviewing the subject application, NMOCD records indicate a producing Bluitt-San Andres oil well located to the west in Unit "O", being UNOCAL's Federal "18" Well No. 1 in which the W/2 SE/4 of said Section 18 is dedicated to form a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

Rule 5(b) of the "General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools in Northwest and Southeast New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-5353, as amended, prohibits the simultaneous dedication of any acreage to an oil well and a gas well, as it appears your application is requesting.

Should any of my information be incorrect or out-dated, please clarify. If not, you may wish to amend this application and request a E/2 SE/4 "80-acre" dedication for the subject well.
