
As shown by EXHIBIT A, a current 240-acre non-standard proration unit for Eumont gas production was established by order NSP 415 for the SE/4 and S/2 SW/4 of section 11. Since there are no longer any active Eumont gas wells dedicated to this NSPU, Conoco requests that this order be set aside so that a new NSPU may be formed for a proposed drilling well, the Sanderson A No. 18.

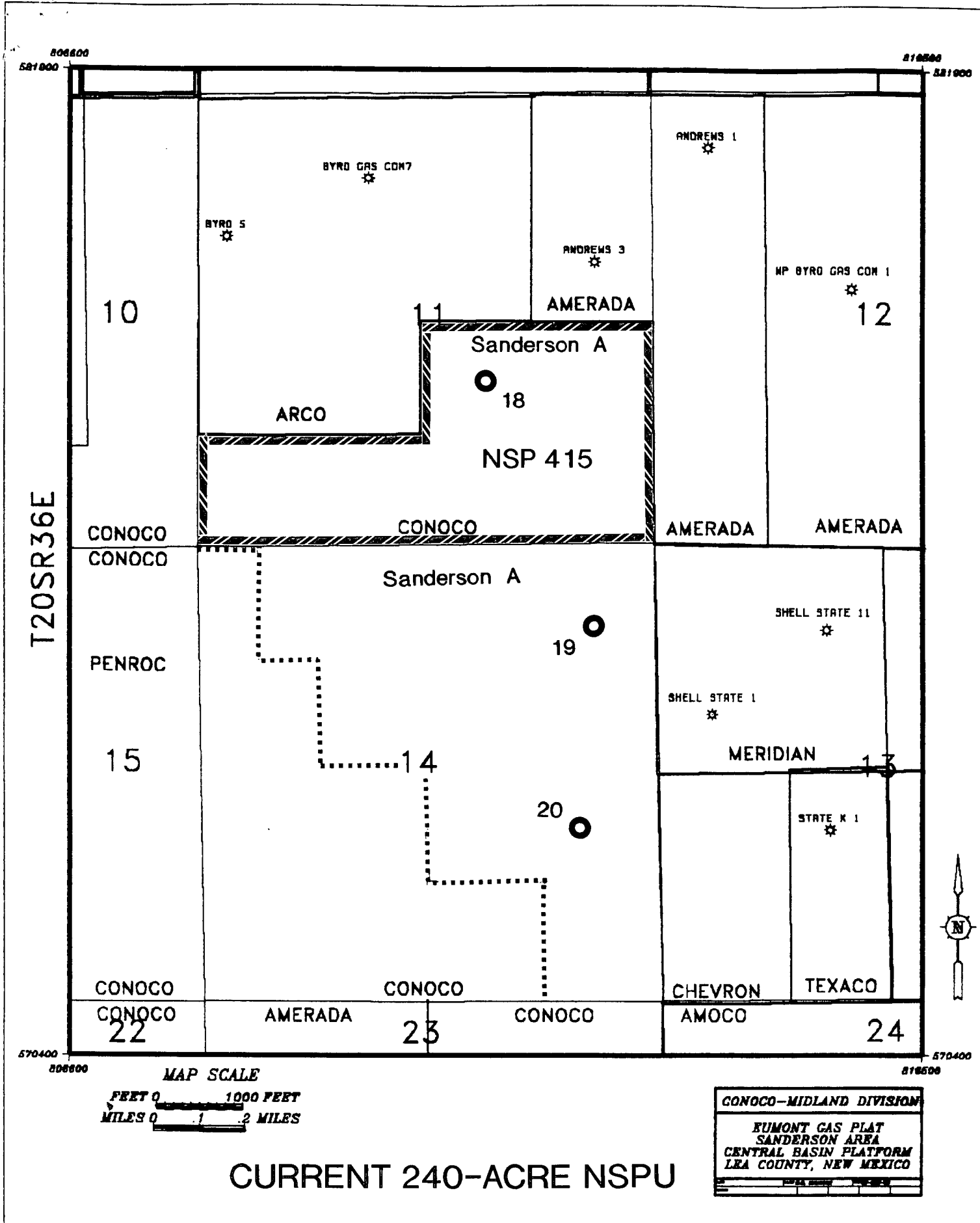
Conoco requests that an administrative order be issued to establish a new 160-acre NSPU consisting of the SE/4 section 11 as shown in EXHIBIT B and that the proposed Sanderson A No. 18 be dedicated to it. This new well will be drilled at a standard location for a 160-acre NSPU.

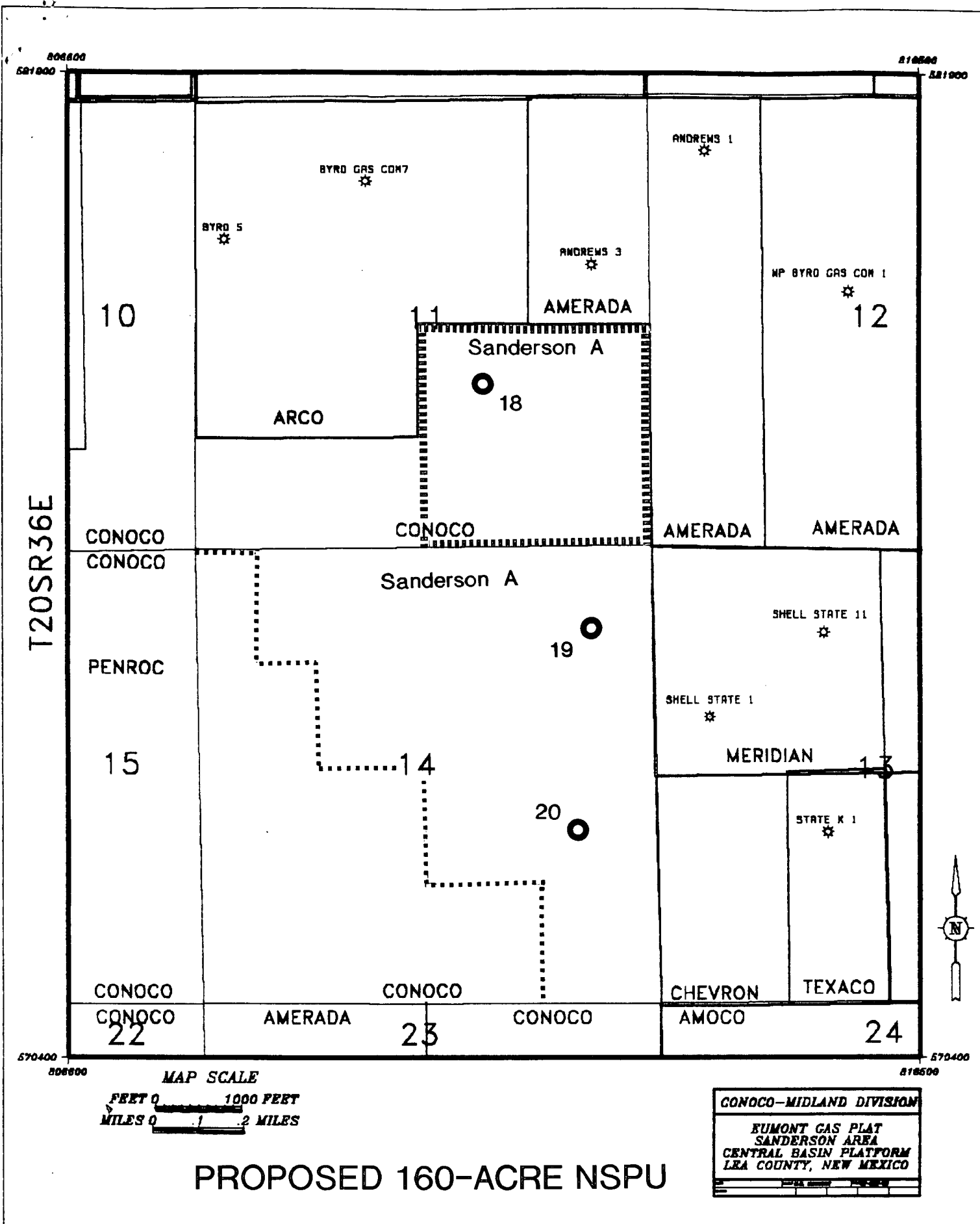
