Reference is made to your application dated January 3, 1994 for a 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Tubb Oil and Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO

Section 35: N/2 NE/4 and SW/4 NE/4
