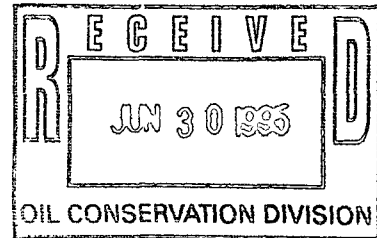

Gentlemen:

Mewbourne Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval for a non-standard 160 acre gas proration unit consisting of the SE/4 of Section 21, T20S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, for a Eumont gas well, the Eumont "21" Federal No. 1 located in Unit O. A lease plat is attached showing the location of this well.

The Eumont "21" Federal No. 1 is a new well. Approval of this request will protect correlative rights, promote conservation, and encourage the efficient recovery of gas reserves. The proposed proration unit will consist of contiguous lots and lie wholly within a single governmental section. The length or width of the proration unit will not exceed 5280 feet.

By copy of this letter, we are notifying the offset operators of this proposed non-standard proration unit. If these operators have no objections we ask that they execute the attached waiver and return two copies to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

Per our telephone conversation today I will hold your application for the formation of the subject 160-acre GPU until such time as I receive a "like" application for the formation of a 160-acre GPU in the NE/4 of said Section 21. As we discussed the E/2 of this section is currently simultaneously dedicated to Amoco Production Company's Gillully "B" Federal R/A "A" Well Nos. 6Y, 17 and 2, see copies of Division Order No. R-835 and Administrative Order NSL-3110(SD). Since a proration unit can only have one operator it will be necessary for Amoco to file a similar application to formally rescind this 320-acre unit.
