Reference is made to your application dated March 22, 1996 on behalf of the operator, Williams Production Company, for a non-standard 232.43-acre, more or less, gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool:

RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NMPM</u> Irregular Section 19: Lots 3 and 4 and the SE/4 (S/2 equivalent)

It is our understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 159 to be drilled at a standard gas well location 790 feet from the South line and 1850 feet from the East line (Unit O) of said irregular Section 19.
