Dear Mr. Ryan:

Reference is made to your application dated April 24, 1998 for a 40-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") consisting of the following acreage in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM  
Section 23: SE/4 NW/4.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your existing Ollie J. Boyd Well No. 4 (API No. 30-025-10436), located at a standard gas well location for the subject 40-acre GPU 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of said Section 23.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "*Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool*," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described 40-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved. Also, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU, in accordance with Rule 5 of said pool rules based upon a unit size of 40 acres.
