Reference is made to your letter dated August 28, 2001, in which you requested that the EMSU No. 271 be re-instated as an injection well within the Eunice Monument South Unit Waterflood Project. It is our understanding that the well was originally permitted for injection by Division Order No. R-7766, and that the well was utilized during a portion of 1997-98, as a producing well.

The EMSU No. 271 is hereby re-instated as an injection well within the above-described waterflood project, provided however that the well shall be tested for mechanical integrity prior to resuming injection operations.

Please contact the Hobbs District Office of the Division to advise them of the date and time the mechanical integrity test will be performed on the well in order that the test may be witnessed.
