

These matters came on for hearing before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, DAVID R. CATANACH and DAVID K. BROOKS, JR., Hearing Examiners, on Thursday, March 13th, 2003, at the New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Room 102, Santa Fe, New Mexico, Steven T. Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 8:15 a.m.: 2 EXAMINER CATANACH: Call the hearing to order 3 this morning for Docket Number 09-03. We will call the 4 continuances and dismissals at this point. 5 On page 1, Case 13,010 is dismissed. Case 13,011 6 is dismissed. 7 On page 2, Case 13,034 is dismissed. Case 13,045 8 is dismissed. Case 13,046 is dismissed. 9 10 On page 3, Case 13,047 is continued to May 22nd. 11 On page 4, Case 13,050 is continued to May 8th. 12 And that's all the continuances and dismissals. 13 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay --14 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I have three more 15 continuances, if you want to take them at this time, or I 16 can wait. 17 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. 18 EXAMINER CATANACH: We can do them now, Mr. 19 Kellahin. 20 MR. KELLAHIN: If you'll turn to page 3, the 21 first case is that Chesapeake Operating case, 13,006. 22 Chesapeake believes it's got a settlement with Yates. 23 They've signed the AFE and they're in possession of our 24 operating agreement, but it has not been signed by them. 25 And if you'll continue this one more time, I hope that will

| 3  | EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, I believe I indicated                |
| 4  | that we would.  |
| 5  | MR. KELLAHIN: Yeah, it's been continued twice               |
| 6  | already.  |
| 7  | EXAMINER BROOKS: Yeah, that was my                          |
| 8  | understanding. What period of time are you requesting       |
| 9  | continuance?  |
| 10 | MR. KELLAHIN: Well, till the next docket. That              |
| 11 | will keep pressure on these guys to get this done.          |
| 12 | EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, 13,006 will be continued             |
| 13 | till April 24th.  |
| 14 | MR. KELLAHIN: The next case is a Chesapeake                 |
| 15 | case. Mr. Carr represents Conoco. He's asked me to ask      |
| 16 | you to continue that case on his behalf until May 22nd, and |
| 17 | I do not oppose that continuance. Again, it will allow the  |
| 18 | parties to see if we can't settle this up.                  |
| 19 | There's a dispute over this old Sapient well and            |
| 20 | how to account for the fact the fact that the spacing unit  |
| 21 | dedication has changed from an 80-acre to a 160-acre        |
| 22 | dedication.   |
| 23 | EXAMINER BROOKS: Is this 13,047?                            |
| 24 | MR. KELLAHIN: Yes, sir.                                     |
| 25 | EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, and that's already been              |

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announced, has it not? 1 It was, but that's -- I'm EXAMINER CATANACH: 2 glad you clarified that on the record, Mr. Kellahin. 3 So that will be continued to May 22nd. 4 MR. KELLAHIN: And the last one I have is the one 5 6 at the bottom for Matador, 13,014. Again, Matador believes 7 they have agreement with Arch, and we need another couple 8 of weeks to make sure all the paperwork is exchanged. 9 And Mr. Bruce represents Arch. Unless he has an objection, we'd like to continue that case for two more 10 weeks. 11 I have no objection, Mr. Examiner. 12 MR. BRUCE: As a matter of fact, I'd recommend that. I believe that 13 14 they've exchanged documents, and they're days away from settling the matter. 15 16 EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good, Case Number 13,014 17 will be continued to April 24th. 18 MR.
