Gentlemen:

During the November 5, 2000, meeting it was agreed that there is a definite need to expedite development of the gas reserves underlying the Deep Lease in and adjacent to the San Juan Coal underground area.

It was also agreed that Dugan Production Corporation and Richardson Operating Company would each provide the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) their respective plans of development prior to meeting again.

It is imperative that we continue with this cooperative effort in order to minimize potential development conflict between the coal and gas resources and to establish a master plan of development that all stake holders are aware of and understand.
