Yates Petroleum hereby protests the referenced application of C. W. Trainer for non-standard spacing and for a non-standard proration unit in the S/2 SW/4 of Section 18 of Township 18S-26E in Eddy County, New Mexico.

I believe there is some confusion here. Yates Petroleum owns and operates the Vandiver Com #1 well (API = 30-015-20783) in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 18-18S-26E. Since there are a number of wells in the immediate vicinity with the Vandiver name, it is possible that Mr. Trainer wants to respace a different "Vandiver Well No. 1" at a slightly different location.

Until the confusion dissipates, Yates feels it must protest the Trainer application as submitted since Yates does not want the spacing and proration unit changed at the Yates Vandiver Com #1 in SW/4 SW/4 of Section 18.
