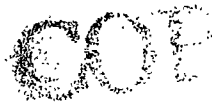

1 EXAMINER BROOKS: We will call the docket to
2 order.

3 Is Phillip Brewer here?

4 MR. BRUCE: He's not here, Mr. Examiner. He
5 did enter an appearance in the case, and I was going to
6 note that on the record.

7 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yeah. He entered an
8 appearance in the application of Mewbourne Oil Company
9 for a non-standard spacing unit and compulsory pooling
10 with no cause number. And most of the cases on the
11 docket are for applications of non-standard spacing
12 units and compulsory pooling.

13 MR. BRUCE: It's 14607.

14 EXAMINER BROOKS: Pardon me?

15 MR. BRUCE: It's 14607.

16 EXAMINER BROOKS: 14607, okay. We'll get it
17 in the proper file.

18 With that preliminary out of the way then, ladies
19 and gentlemen, we will proceed with Docket Number 6-11
20 of the Oil Conservation Division. And we will begin, as
21 usual, with the continuances and dismissals.

22 On page 1, Case Number 14413 is continued to
23 March 31st; Case Number 14602 is continued to
24 March 17th; on page 2, Case Number 14415 is continued to
25 March 17th; Case Number ~~14416~~ is continued to

1 March 17th; on page 3, Case Number 14593 is continued to
 2 March 17th; Case Number 14609 is continued to
 3 March 17th; Case Number 13940, I'm sure everybody will
 4 be surprised to learn, is continued again this time to
 5 May the 12th; Case Number 13940 -- yeah, that's the one
 6 I just called; on page 4, Case Number 14569 is continued
 7 to March 17th; Case Number 14570 is continued to
 8 March 17th; Case Number 8352 is continued to March 31st.

9 That's all the continuances and dismissals that I
 10 have. Is there anything else?

11 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 5, the
 12 bottom case, Nadel and Gussman, 14551?

13 EXAMINER BROOKS: Page 5. Okay, yes?

14 MR. BRUCE: Please continue that to
 15 March 17th. Ocean Munds-Dry entered an appearance in
 16 that case but she does not object to the continue.

17 EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good. Case
 18 Number 14551 will be continued to March 17th.
