The following documents, data, information, and items in your possession, custody, or control regarding the Nash Unit SWD Well No. 53 (API No. 30-015-39400), a salt water disposal well located 1620 feet from the North line and 1120 feet from the East line (Unit Letter H) of Section 13, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico (the "Well"):
