Applicant, Devon Energy Production Company, L.P., seeks an order (1) authorizing a non-standard spacing unit in the Purple Sage Wolfcamp Gas Pool (98220); (2) creating a 480acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the SW/4 of Section 30 and the W/2 of Section 31, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (3) pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying this acreage. Devon is a working interest owner in the subject acreage. The 480-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the proposed (a) Spud Muffin 30-31 Fed Com 731H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 30 (Unit L) to a bottom hole location in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 31 (Unit M); (b) Spud Muffin 30-31 Fed Com 732H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 30 (Unit L) to a bottom hole location in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 31 (Unit M); (c) Spud Muffin 31-30 Com 733H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 31 (Unit N) to a bottom hole location in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 30 (Unit K); and (d) Spud Muffin 31-30 Com 734H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 31 (Unit N) to a bottom hole location in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 30 (Unit K).
