The Encana 2018 Plan of Development for the North Alamito Unit (NAU) located in San Juan County, New Mexico is approved as of March 8, 2018 because there are two horizontal Mancos wells planned, the NAU #232H and #233H. There were three horizontal Mancos wells the NAU #306, #307 and #308 drilled and completed in 2017.

The NU contains 14,262 acres of Federal, State, Patented and Navajo Allotted lands and has a total of nine producing Mancos horizontal wells with first production occurring from the NU #322H, #323H and #328H all in Nov. of 2014.
