Dear Mr. Black and Mr. Campbell:

All of the submitted WPX Energy 2018 Plans of Development (POD) for Federal units located in San Juan, Rio Arriba and Sandoval Counties, New Mexico are approved as of March 9, 2018. A POD is required to be filed yearly by the unit operator and not later than March 1 of each year. No extension of time will be granted unless an Unavoidable Delay where justified. The list of units below identifies all POD's which were submitted and approved.

It is noteworthy that WPX Energy has been actively developing their units not only in 2017 but in prior years as well. With the pending sale of these assets to Enduring Resources it is really up to them (Enduring Resources) to provide their plans for development in 2018. Sufficient time will be granted in order to develop these plans.

The unit POD's listed below will be closely looked at because they contain Navajo allotted lands and the BLM has a trust responsibility to ensure their diligent development occurs.
