The Encana, 2018 Plan of Development for the Corrales Canyon Unit (CCU) located in Sandoval County, New Mexico is approved as of March 7, 2018 because there are no Allotted or Tribal lands within the unit. The CCU contains 2,560 acres of Federal and State minerals and has one producing Mancos well the CCU #101H which first produced in May of 2014.

Your 2018 plan contains installation of valves to isolate and de-pressure the tank vapor recovery system for increased safe operation.
