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STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Case No. 16310: Kaiser-Francis Oil Company applies for an order approving a 471.03 acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of Lots 1-4 and the E/2W/2 (W/2) of Section 19 and Lots 1 and 2 and the E/2NW/4 (NW/4) of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard unit. Applicant proposes to drill the Wright Fee WC Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SE/4NW/4 of Section 30, and a terminus in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 19. The beginning and end of the producing interval of the well will be orthodox. Applicant seeks to dedicate the W/2 of Section 19 and the NW/4 of Section 30 to the well to form a non-standard 471.03 acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation.

Case No. 16310: Kaiser-Francis Oil Company applies for an order approving a 480 acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of E/2 of Section 19 and the NE/4 of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard unit. Applicant proposes to drill the Wright Fee WC Well No. 2H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 30, and a terminus in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 19. The beginning and end of the producing interval of the well will be orthodox. Applicant seeks to dedicate the E/2 of Section 19 and the NE/4 of Section 30 to the well to form a non-standard 480 acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation.
