STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Matador Production Company has filed the following applications:

- Case No. 16350, for compulsory pooling, regarding the Dr. Ireland Fed. Com. Well No. 113H, a Bone Spring well in the W/2E/2 of Section 19;
- 2. Case No. 16351, for compulsory pooling, regarding the Dr. Ireland Fed. Com. Well No. 114H, a Bone Spring well in the E/2E/2 of Section 19;
- 3. Case No. 16352, for compulsory pooling, regarding the Dr. Ireland Fed. Com. Well No. 213H, a Wolfcamp well in the W/2E/2 of Section 19; and
- 4. Case No. 16353, for compulsory pooling, regarding the Dr. Ireland Fed. Com. Well No. 214H, a Wolfcamp well in the E/2E/2 of Section 19.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
