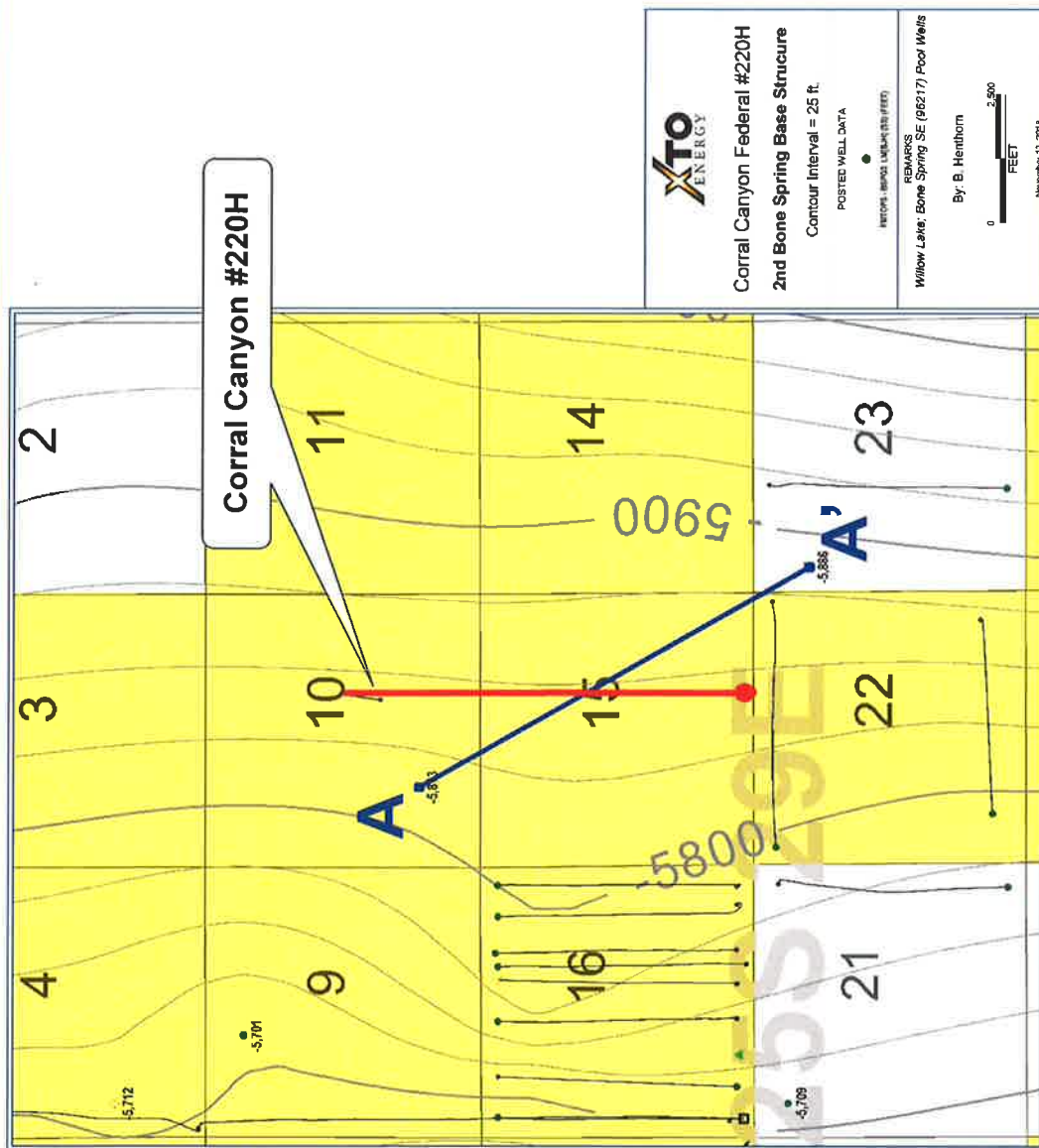


2nd Bone Spring Structure Map

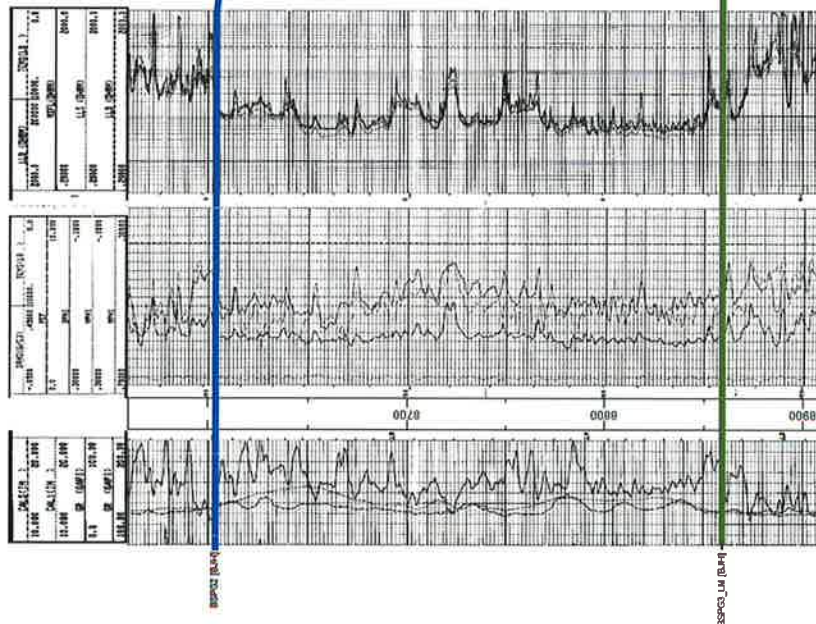
