Item 5. <u>Limited Rehearing of Case No. 16078 (Rulemaking)</u>: In the matter of

proposed amendments to the Commission Rules on Financial Assurance and Plugging and Abandonment of Wells, 19.15.2, 19.15.8, and 19.15.25

of New Mexico (IPANM), and Larry Marker pro se. Mr. Brooks and Mr. Marker made opening statements.

OCD's witness was Daniel Sanchez, Compliance and Enforcement Manager for the OCD in Santa Fe, New Mexico. He explained that the proposed amendments were limited to changes to 19.15.8 NMAC which pertained to the applicability of financial assurance requirements to federal wells. If a well is covered by federally required financial assurance, 19.15.8 NMAC does not require additional financial assurance. Mr. Larson and Counsel Brancard cross-examined the witness, and he was excused.

The Commission requested the position of the parties on the effective date for the revision of the rule. Each of the parties supported an immediate effective date for new wells and a delay of 90 days for existing wells. Mr.Larson said that IPANM supports the amendments to the financial assurance rule proposed at this hearing and supports the adoption of the proposed rule. Mr. Marker stated that he supported the changes related to federal financial assurance but he remains opposed to the proposed tiers for blanket bonds and the changes to single well financial assurance.

After deliberations, Commissioner Balch moved to accept the language as proposed by OCD, Commissioner Martin seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Martin moved to accept the effective dates of the proposed rule, Commissioner Balch seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously. The Commission agreed that the existing order for this case should be replaced with a new order incorporating all changes agreed to at this hearing. A motion was made by Commissioner Balch and seconded by Commissioner Martin allowing Chair Riley to sign the order as soon as it was prepared. The case was closed.

Item 6. <u>Case No. 15844 (De Novo)</u>: Amended Application of XTO Energy Inc. for the Approval of the Expansion of the James Ranch Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico.
