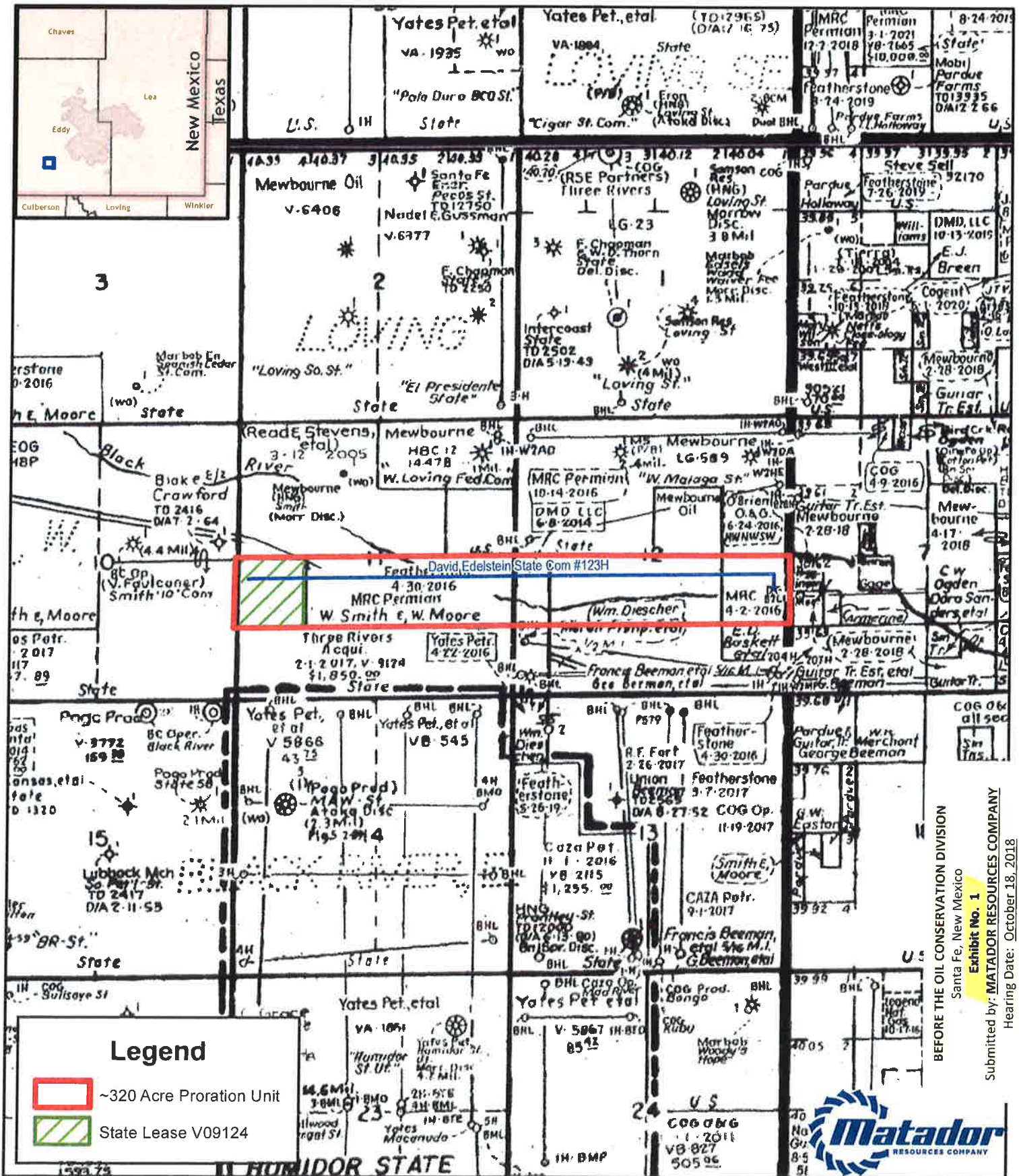

MRC Permian Company (“MRC”) proposes the drilling of Matador Production David Edelstein State Com #123H well, located in Section 12 & 11, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, to the Bone Spring formation.

MRC requests that you indicate your election to participate in the drilling and completion of the Well in the space provided below, sign and return one (1) copy of this letter to the undersigned.

In connection with the above, please note the following:

- The estimated cost of drilling, testing, completing, and equipping the Well is \$11,178,702 as itemized on the enclosed Authority for Expenditure (“AFE”) dated June 4, 2018.
- The proposed surface location of the Well is approximately 2046’ FSL and 330’ FEL of Section 12, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed bottom hole location of the subject well is approximately 2420’ FSL and 240’ FWL of Section 11, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- The Well will have a targeted interval within the Bone Spring formation. We plan to drill the Well horizontally in the Bone Spring (~7,780’ TVD) to a Total Measured Depth of approximately 18,125’ resulting in a productive lateral of approximately 9,500’.

MRC reserves the right to modify the locations and drilling plans described above in order to address topography, cultural or environmental concerns, among other reasons. MRC will advise you of any such modifications.

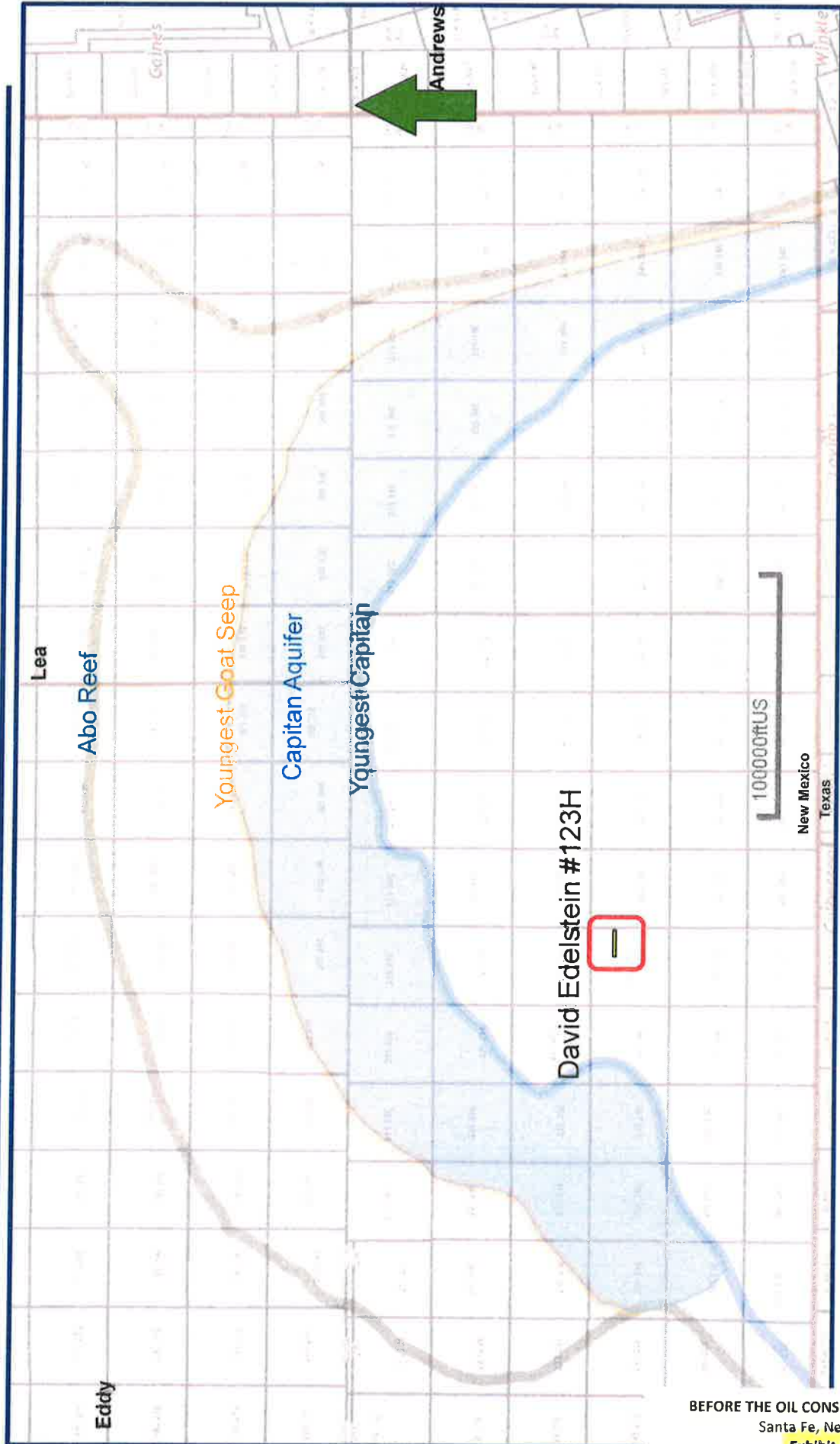

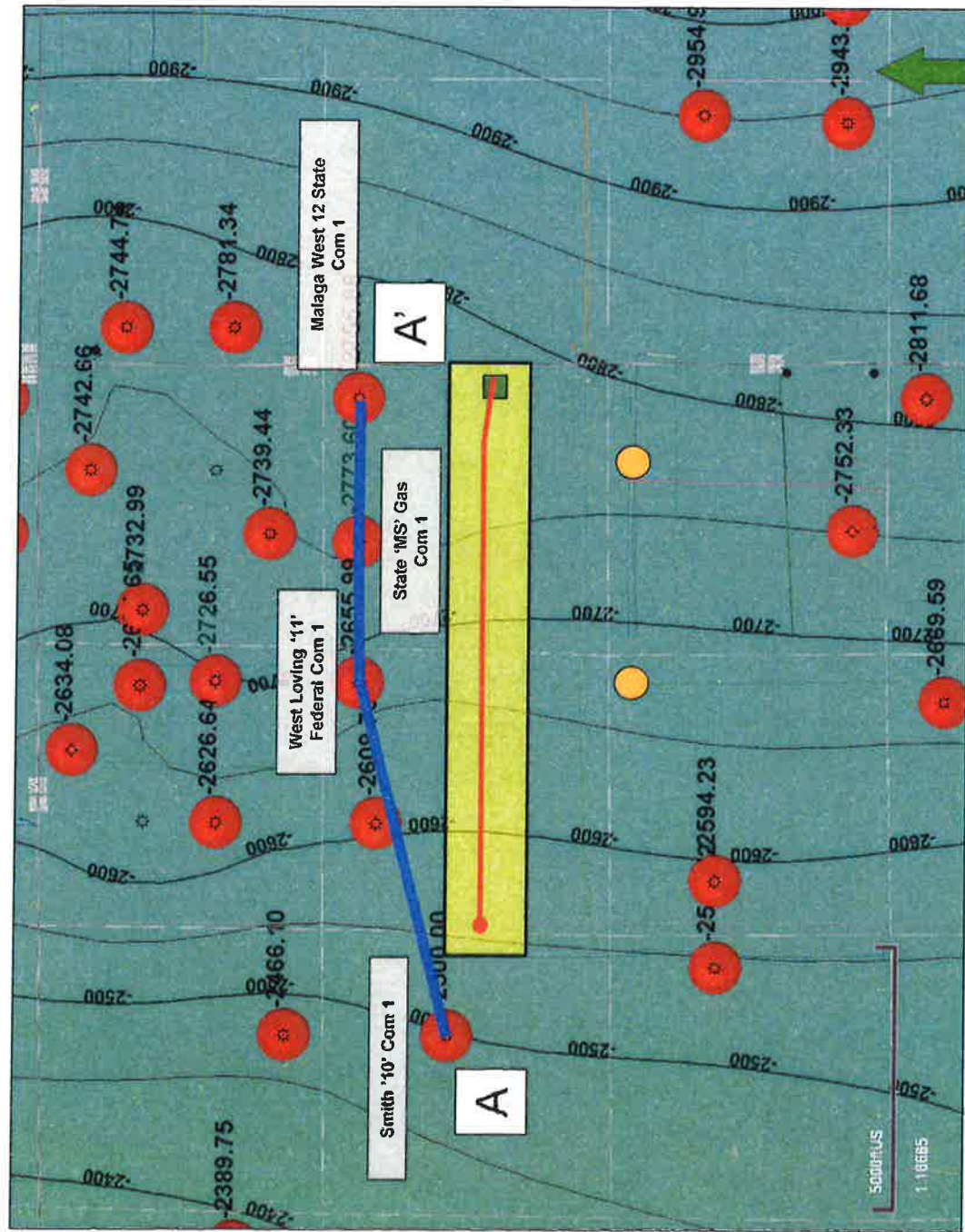

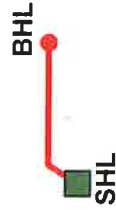

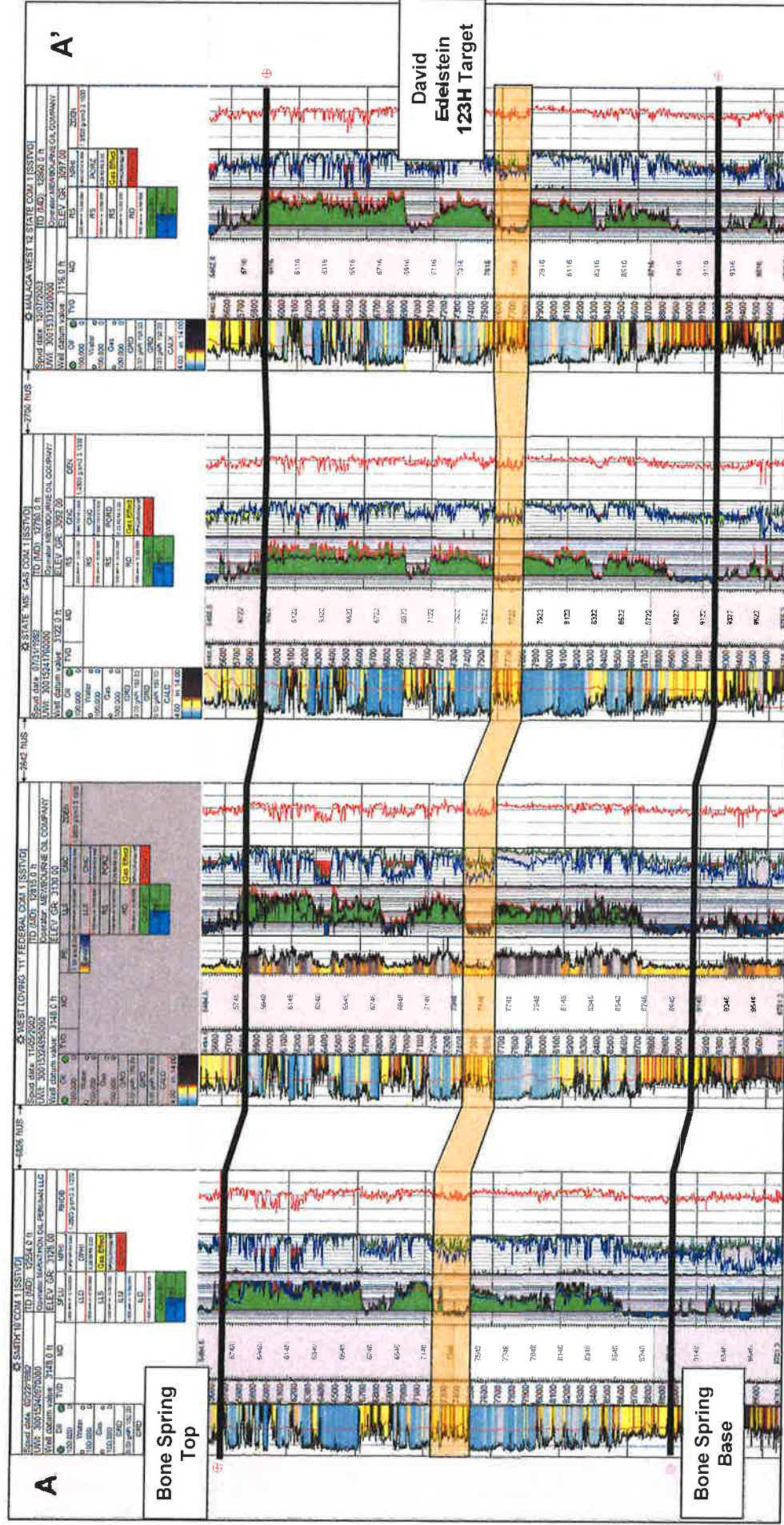

Willow Lake; Bone Spring, West (Pool Code 96415) Cross Section



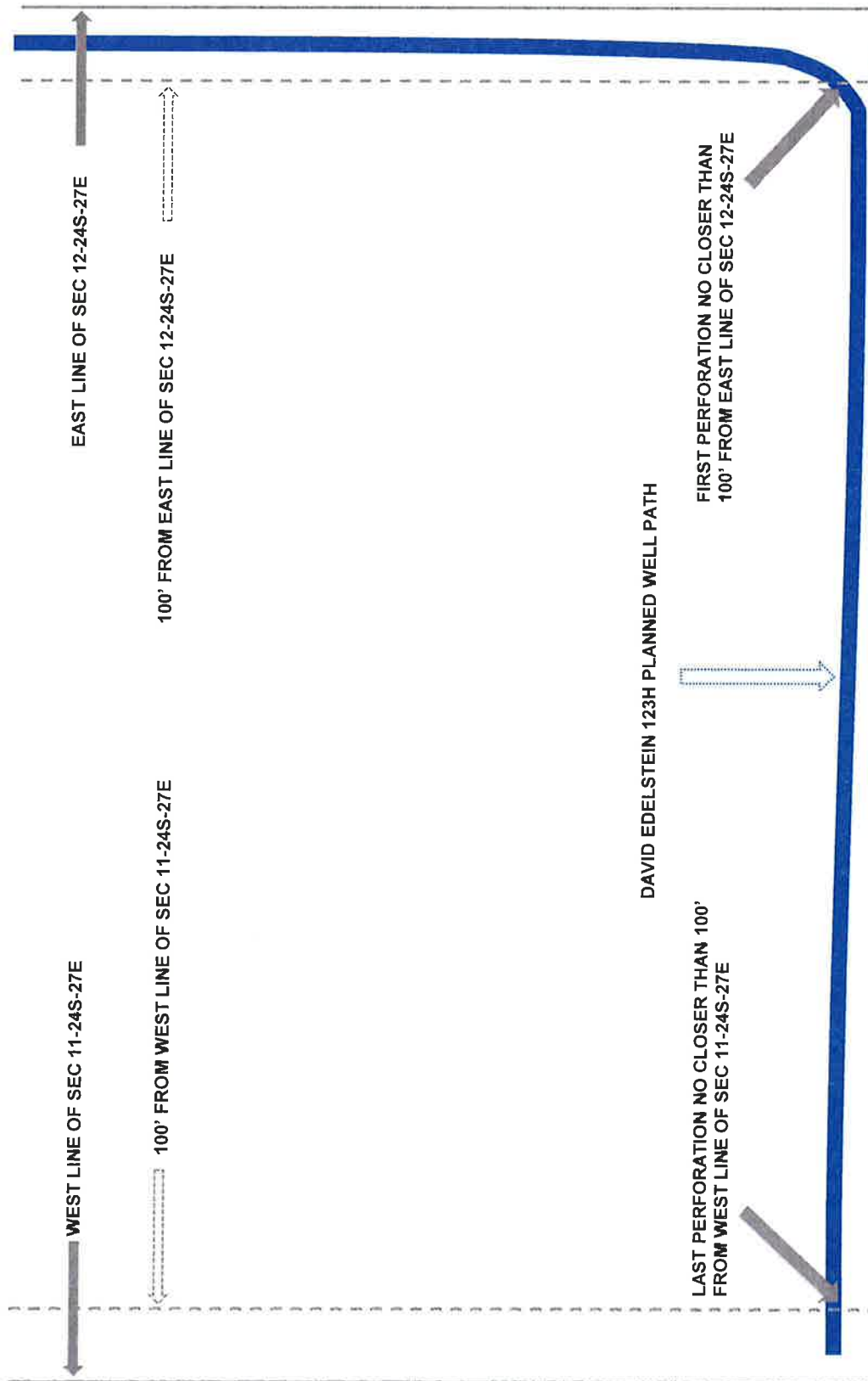
