STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In Case No. 20220, Applicant seeks an order from the Division dedicating the E/2 of Section 15, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County New Mexico to form a 320-acre, more or less, spacing unit and pool all uncommitted mineral interests within the Wolfcamp formation underlying the proposed spacing unit, and .

In Case No. 20221, Applicant seeks an order from the Division dedicating the E/2 of Section 15, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County New Mexico to form a 320-acre, more or less, spacing unit and pool all uncommitted mineral interests within the Bone Spring formation underlying the proposed spacing unit.

Tap Rock is an uncommitted working interest owner in the proposed units and opposes these applications on the ground, *inter alia*, that Marathon has failed to engage in good faith negotiations with Tap Rock before proceeding to hearing.
