ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on April 4, 2019, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Phillip R. Goetze.

NOW, on this 9th day of April 2019, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice has been given, and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and of the subject matter.
- (2) Due to the withdrawal of the sole objection at this hearing by an affected party, the Applicant has requested its case be dismissed and the matter remanded to the Division's administrative review process.
- (3) Prior to the hearing, the Division assessed the proposed Roadrunner SWD No. 1 with respect to both pending applications and approved injection orders within a 1.5-mile radius of the well's surface location and with the same disposal interval. Based on this review, the Division does not object to the proposed surface location and does not oppose remanding the application to the Division's administrative review process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 20405 is hereby dismissed and the application by Solaris Water Midstream, LLC for authorization to conduct injection operations is remanded to the Division's administrative review process.
