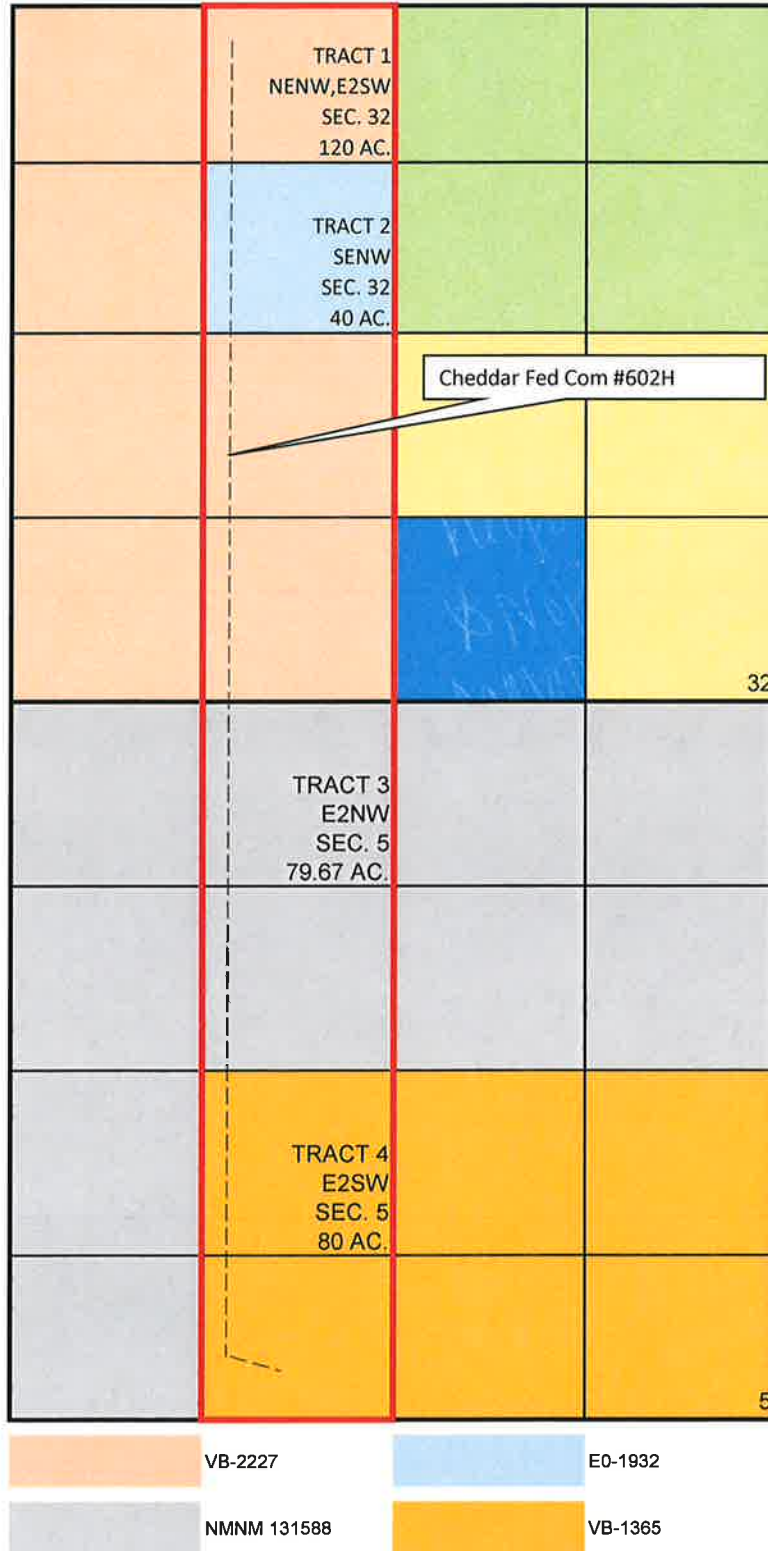

Centennial Resource Production, LLC ("CRP") proposes to drill and complete the Cheddar Federal Com 602H as a horizontal well to test the Bone Spring Formation at a TVD of 11,640 feet. The E/2 W/2 of the referenced Sections 32 and 5 will be dedicated to the well as the proration unit being a total of 320 acres. Please see the enclosed AFE in the amount of \$12,849,525.00.

Upon your response we will send a Joint Operating Agreement ("JOA") with an effective date of March 1, 2019, covering Township 22 South, Range 32 East, Section 5: E/2 W/2 & Township 21 South, Range 32 East, Section 32: E/2 W/2. The JOA contains a proposed overhead rate of \$7500 per day for drilling and \$750 per day for producing and provides for a 100%/300%/300% non-consent penalty.

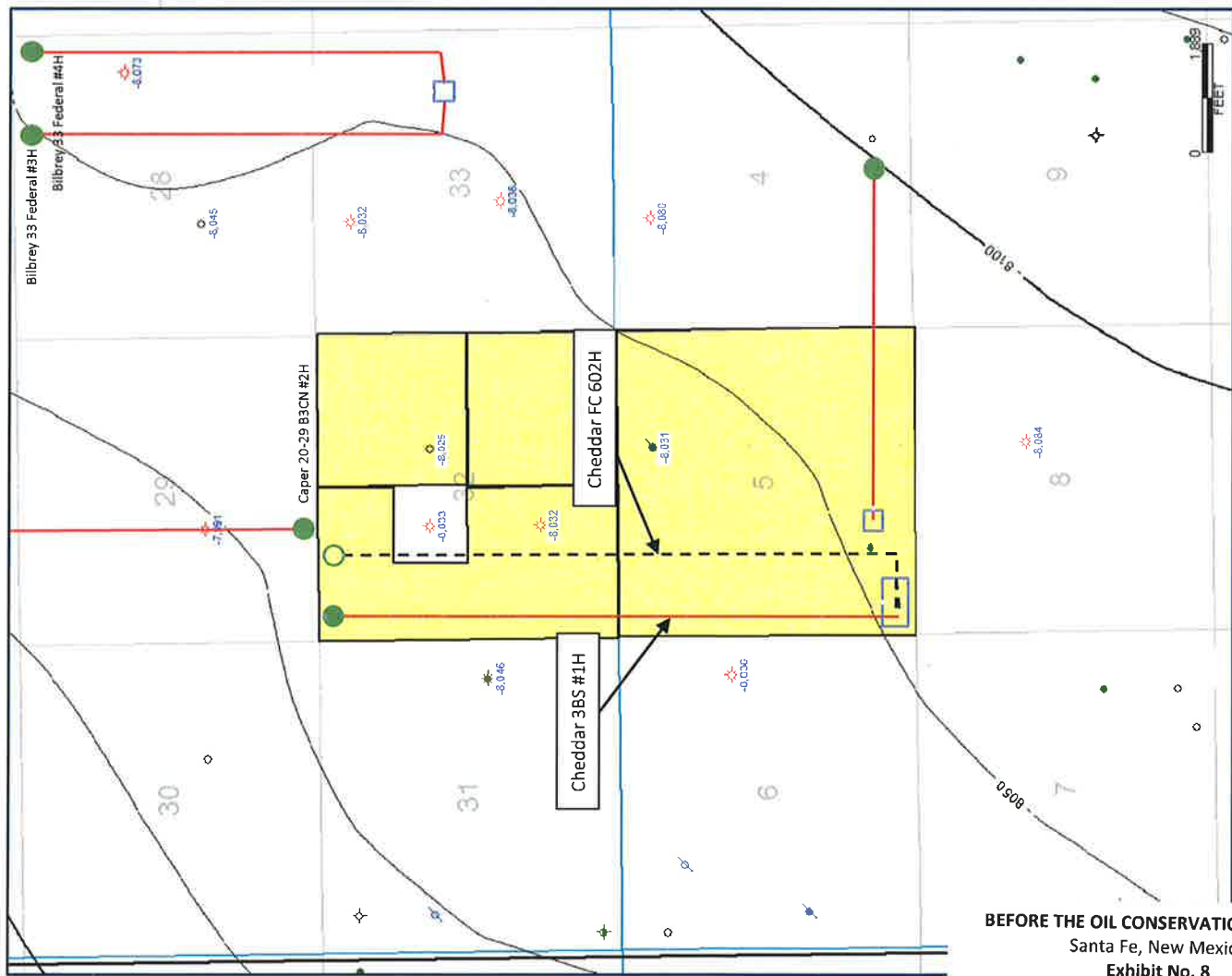

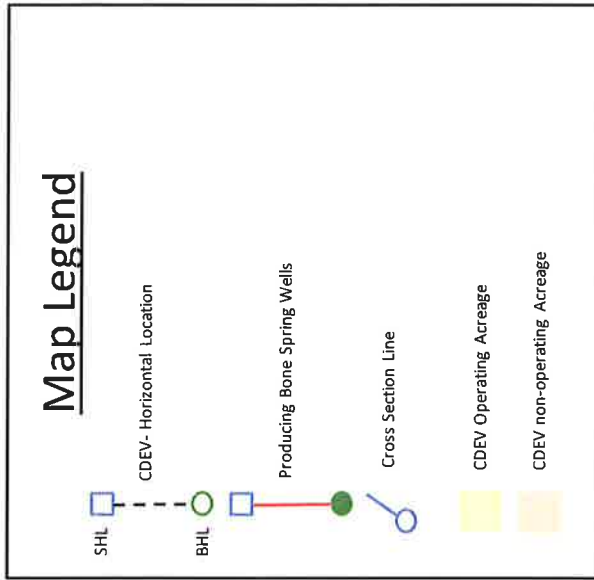
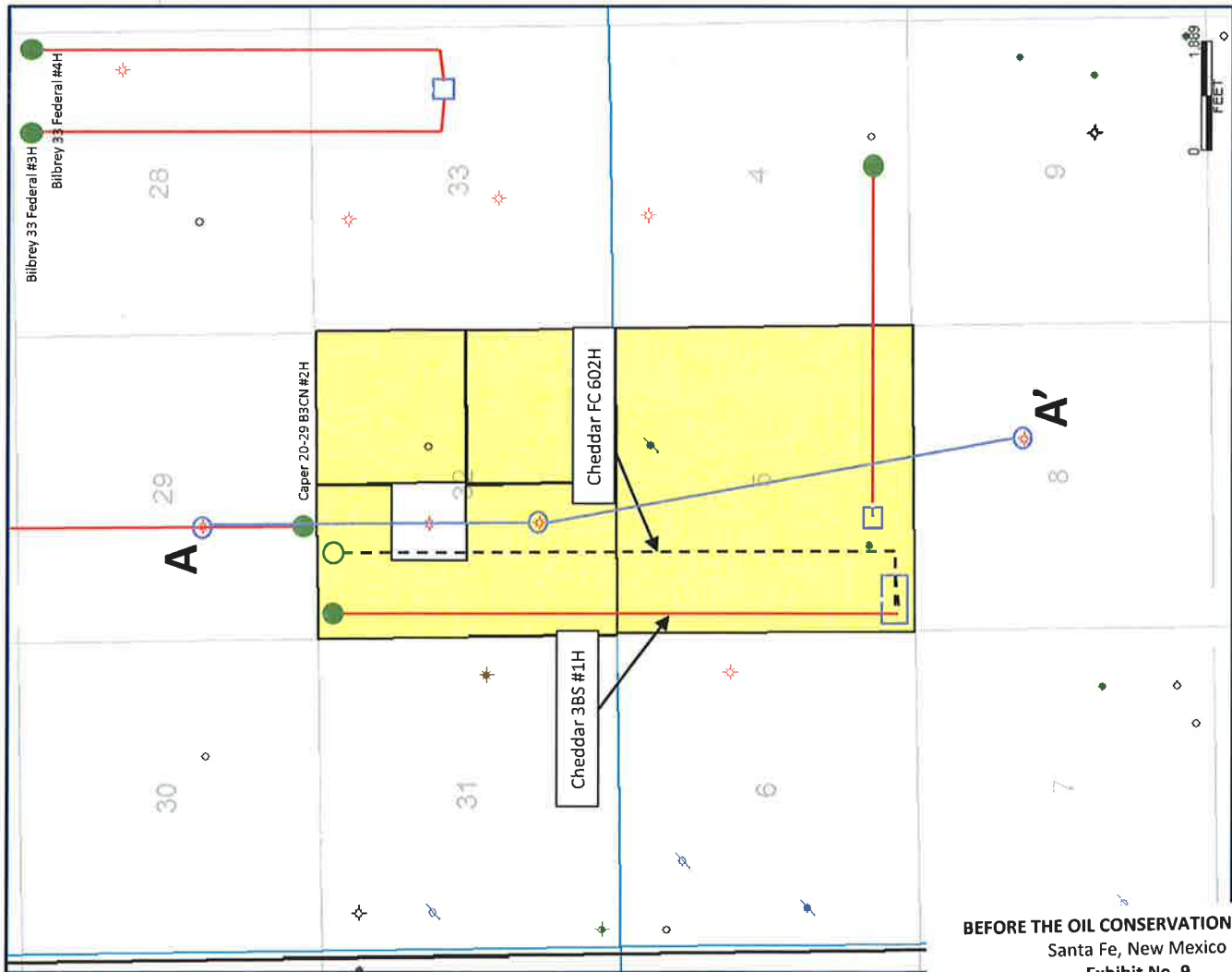
Bone Spring Pool

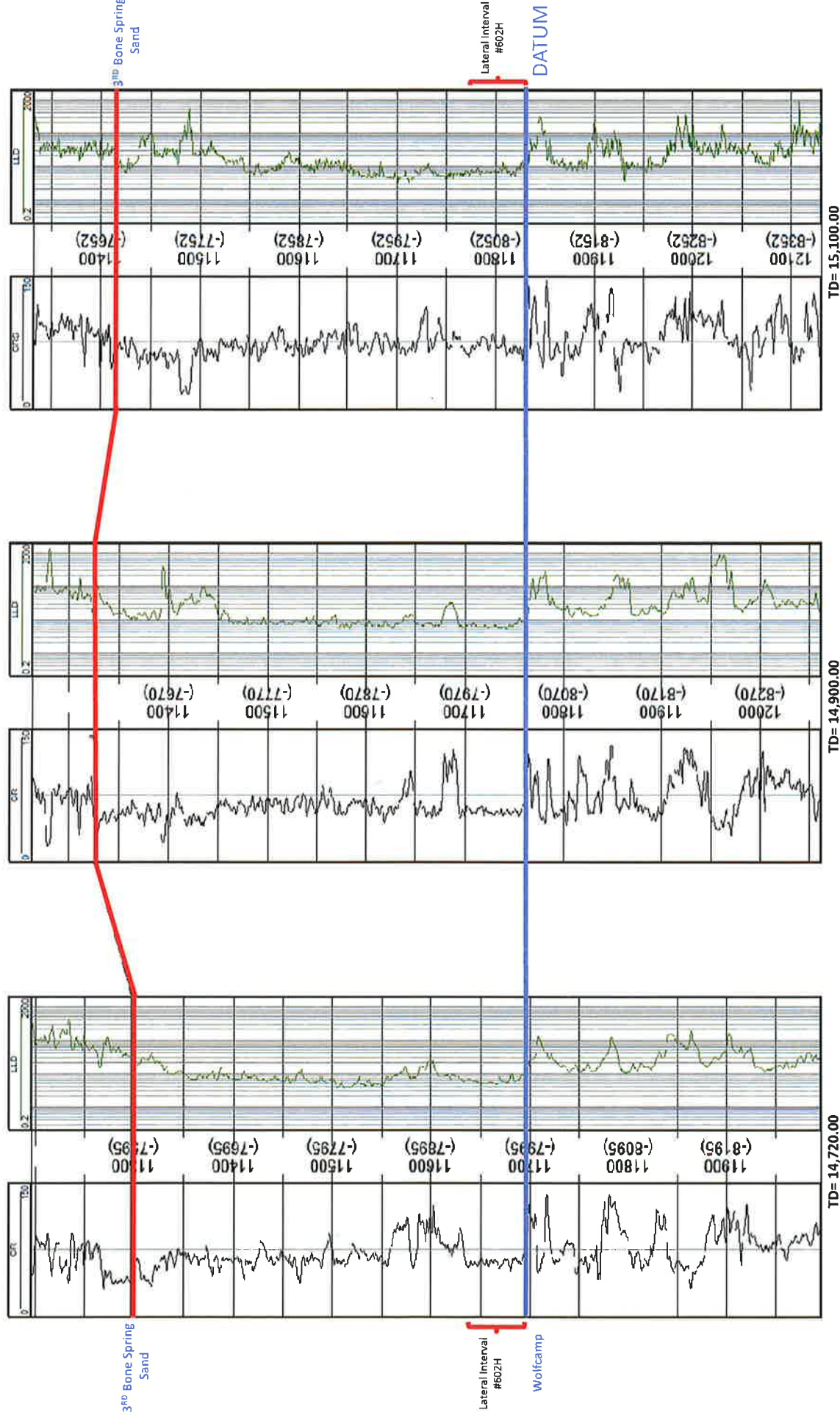
