APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASES

In Case No. 20786, OXY seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Pierce Crossing; Bone Spring, East (96473)) underlying a standard 640-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the W/2 of Sections 4 and 9, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. OXY seeks to dedicate this spacing unit to the following proposed initial wells:

• The Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #21H Well, and the Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #22H Well, both of which will be horizontally drilled from a common surface

location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 9 to bottom-hole locations in the NW/4 NW/4 (Lot 4) of Section 4.

• The **Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #23H Well** to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 9 to a bottom-hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Lot 3) of Section 4.

The completed interval for the **Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #22H Well** will remain within 330 feet of the E/2 W/2 of Sections 4 and 9 to allow inclusion of these proximity tracts in a standard 640-acre horizontal well spacing comprised of W/2 of Sections 4 and 9.

In Case No. 20813, OXY seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation (Pierce Crossing; Bone Spring, East (96473)) underlying a standard 640-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Sections 4 and 9, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. OXY seeks to dedicate this spacing unit to the following proposed initial wells:

- The Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #24H Well and the Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #25H Well, both of which will be horizontally drilled from a common surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 9 to bottom-hole locations in the NW/4 NE/4 (Lot 2) of Section 4.
- The Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #26H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 9 to a bottom-hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Lot 1) of Section 4.

The completed interval for the **Heads CC 9-4 Fed Com #25H Well** will be within 330 feet of the E/2 E/2 of Sections 4 and 9 to allow inclusion of these proximity tracts in a standard 640-acre horizontal well spacing comprised of E/2 of Sections 4 and 9.
